ABOUT ROCKFORD UNIVERSITY

Rockford University is a four-year, co-educational institution founded in 1847, offering undergraduate and graduate degrees in traditional liberal arts and professional fields. Rockford offers approximately 80 majors, minors and concentrations, including the bachelor's degree completion program for a B.S. in Management Studies. Through their Graduate Studies department, degrees are

extended to include the <u>Master of Business Administration (MBA)</u> and <u>Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)</u>, and a <u>Master of Education (M.Ed.)</u>

In addition to the degree programs, Rockford University offers the following programs.

- The HUB: Academic Coaching & Testing Services—offers academic success opportunities to RU students. The HUB emphasizes quality academic coaching with a strong commitment to aid each student in attaining academic potential while directing the student towards independent learning and improved personal achievement.
- <u>English as a Second Language (ESL)</u>—Programming includes listening, speaking, reading, writing, and grammar components for preparation of the TOEFL test

Rockford University is home to one of only 11 Phi Beta Kappa (PBK) chapters in Illinois, the most prestigious honor society in the United States. Named by The Princeton Review as a Best Midwestern College and as a 2018 Best Midwest Regional University by U.S. News and World Report, Rockford currently serves approximately 1,260 full-and part-time students.

An <u>NCAA Division III institution</u>, the university offers 12 intercollegiate varsity teams along with several junior varsity teams and participates in the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference. Accreditation / Distinctions

Since 1913, Rockford University has been accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The nursing program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing, Inc (ACEN).

Rockford has garnered numerous distinctions in recent years, making it an institution that stands out. Among the most notable:

- Academic Excellence: One of 11 colleges and universities in Illinois and 290 in the country with a chapter of Phi Beta Kappa, the oldest and most prestigious liberal arts academic honor society.
- Community Engagement: Rockford University joins just 361 other colleges and universities from across the nation, and one of only 11 in Illinois, to receive the 2015 Community Engagement Classification from The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching. The classification is valid through 2025.
- College with a Conscience: One of 81 U.S. colleges and universities in the <u>Princeton Review book</u>. <u>Colleges with a Conscience</u>, Rockford University was recognized for their strong ethos of civic engagement and the opportunities for community service offered to students.
- Access through Economic Diversity: Ranked by the U.S. News and World Report as an Economically Diverse Regional University, underscoring a long-standing and successful effort to promote access for qualified students to excellent higher education, irrespective of the financial means of those students and their families.
- Student Engagement and Satisfaction: Shown by the 20<u>14 National Survey of Student Engagement</u> as performing at or above U.S. norms on virtually all measures of student engagement.

Patricia Lynott Ph.D. President

Dr. Patricia Lynott joined Rockford University in December 2022 serving as interim President until becoming the 19th President of Rockford University on March 1, 2024. Lynott's almost forty years in higher education includes being a tenured, Associate Professor of Speech, serving as Dean of Graduate and Continuing Education at Elmhurst University, and becoming the founding director of Elmhurst Partners, the university's corporate training division.

Dr. Lynott spent fifteen years at Southern New Hampshire University where she played a critical leadership role in transitioning

a small regional business college into a national, multi-faceted university. During her tenure at SNHU, Lynott served as vice president of academic affairs, university provost, and president of SNHU's University College.

Dr. Lynott's community involvement is extensive. She was a founding member of Manchester Proud, a citizen's coalition dedicated to uniting the City of Manchester behind an aspirational vision for the city's public schools. She served on the steering committee of New Hampshire Scholars, a federally funded, community-based program that encourages students to enroll in a rigorous Core Course of Study in high school. She was also a member of the New Hampshire Advisory Committee of the US Global Leadership Coalition—a network of businesses and NGOs, national security and foreign policy experts, business, faith-based, academic and community leaders who support elevating diplomacy and development alongside defense in order to build a better, safer world.

Dr. Lynott has served on the board of directors of numerous non-profit organizations such as the Fulbright Association; Alpha Sigma Lambda National Honor Society; the Greater Manchester Chamber of Commerce; the World Affairs Council of New Hampshire; America's Credit Union Museum; and the Boys & Girls Club of Manchester. She is currently President of the Board of Governors of the Boys & Girls Club of North Central Illinois.

After graduating magna cum laude from Trinity College, Dr. Lynott completed a master's degree in communication studies from Northern Illinois University. She completed her doctorate at Loyola University Chicago and has a certificate from the Institute for Educational Management at Harvard's Graduate School of Education.

ABOUT THE AREA

ROCKFORD, IL

Rockford is a city located in Winnebago County in northern Illinois. With a population of approximately 150,000, it is the third-largest city in the state outside of the Chicago metropolitan area. The city is situated on both sides of the Rock River, which runs through the city and provides recreational opportunities such as boating and fishing.

Rockford has a diverse economy, with manufacturing being a major industry in the city. It is home to several major companies, including aerospace manufacturer Woodward Inc. and the outdoor equipment company, the Bergstrom Inc. The healthcare sector is also prominent, with Mercy Health System and UW Health being two of the largest employers in the city.

The city is home to several educational institutions, including Rockford University, Rock Valley College, and the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Rockford. The Rockford Public School District is the largest school district in the city and serves over 28,000 students.

Rockford has several cultural attractions, such as the Anderson Japanese Gardens, the Coronado Theatre, and the Burpee Museum of Natural History. The city also hosts numerous events throughout the year, including the Illinois Snow Sculpting Competition and the Rockford AirFest.
