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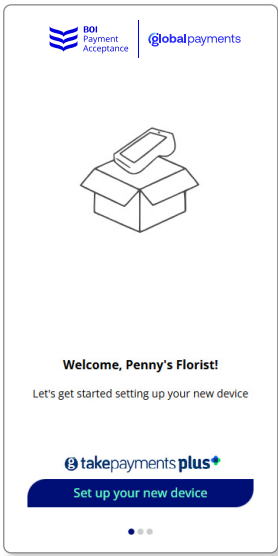
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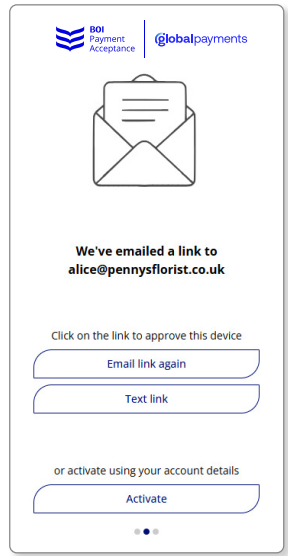
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Getting Started

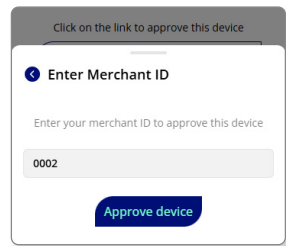
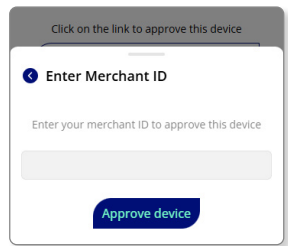
Activation



1 On the welcome screen, you will be presented with your business name. Tap “Set up your new device”.



2 You now need to activate your device and will be automatically sent an activation link to your email. Locate the email and click the “Approve Device” button to activate your device.

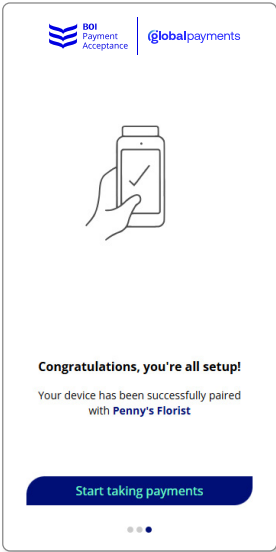


Alternatively, tap “Text link” to receive the activation link to the mobile number associated to your account, or tap “Enter merchant ID” to activate your terminal app using your acquiring merchant ID.

Activation (continued)

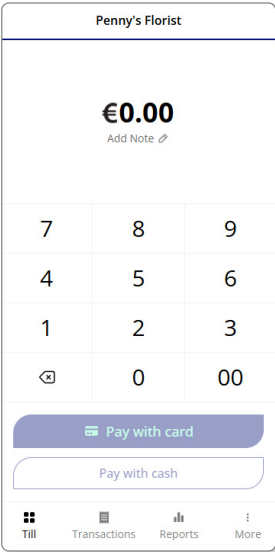


3 Next, enter a 4 digit supervisor PIN of your choosing, and tap "Set PIN". Make sure to keep this safe as you will need the supervisor PIN for certain actions on the terminal app.

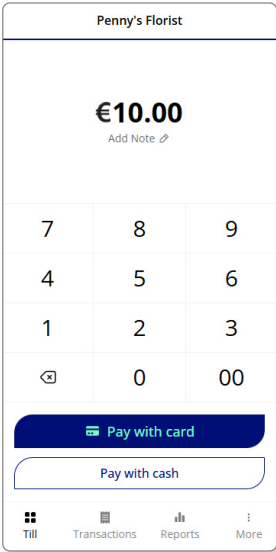


4 After a few seconds of activating, your device will confirm you are all setup and you can complete by pressing "Start taking payments".

Taking a payment



1 Enter the payment amount using the keypad onscreen.



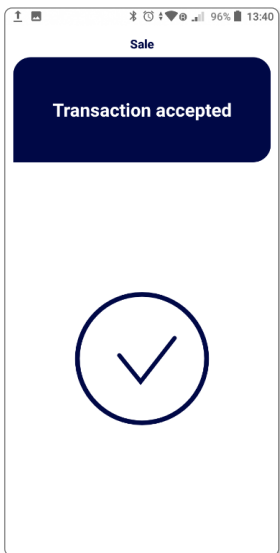
2 Tap "Pay with card" or "Pay with cash" to navigate to the payment.

Completing by Card (Contactless)

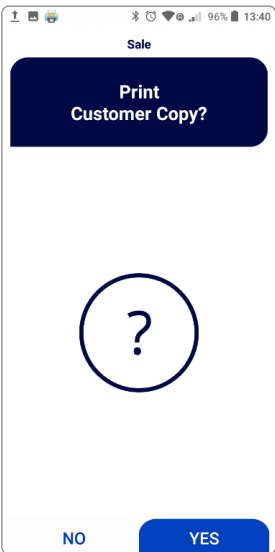


1 When prompted, ask the customer to present the card to the top edge of the terminal on the contactless logo.

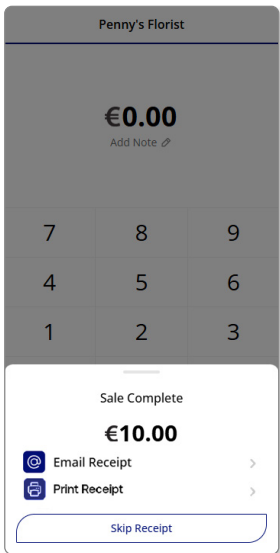
2 Once the screen displays "Card read" and beeps, the card can be removed.



3 The transaction will take a few seconds to process and authorise.



4 If card receipt printing is enabled in your terminal app's "More" settings, you will now be prompted with an option to print your cardholder and merchant receipts.



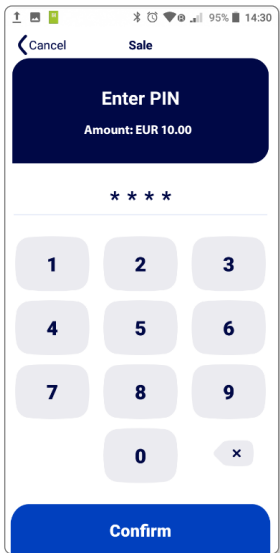
5 Your terminal app will now prompt with options to email, SMS, print, or skip the purchase receipt.

Completing by Card (Chip & PIN)



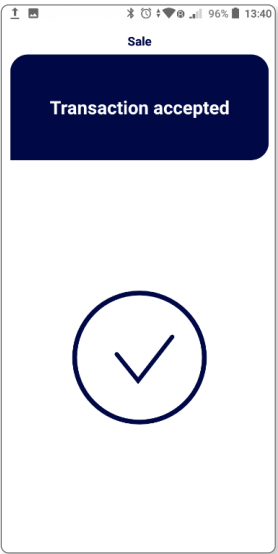

When prompted, ask the customer to insert the payment card.



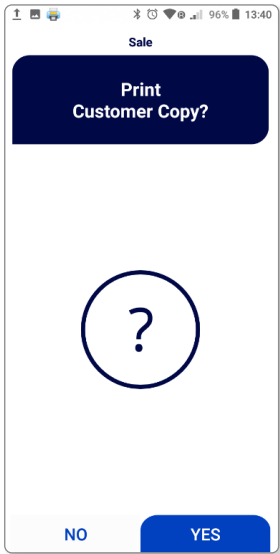

Ask the customer to enter the PIN followed by the green return key.

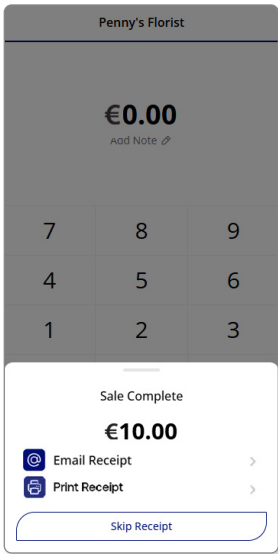
The transaction will take a few seconds to process and authorise.

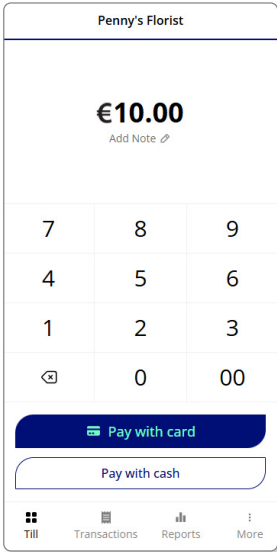
If card receipt printing is enabled in your terminal app's "More" settings, the terminal will print the cardholder copy. Tap "Yes" and the merchant copy will also print.

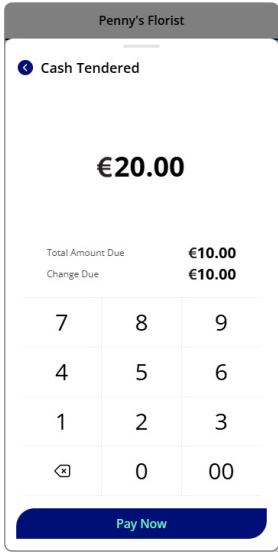

Completing by Cash (Entering amount tendered)



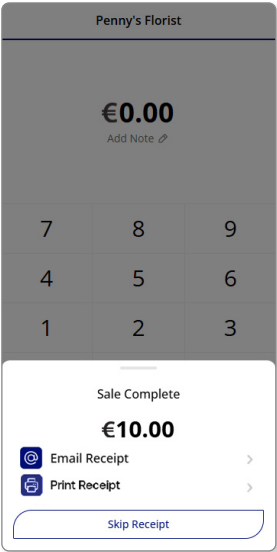
1 You will now be prompted to select "Pay Full Amount" or "Enter Cash Tendered".



2 To enter the amount tendered (paid in cash) tap "Enter Cash Tendered".

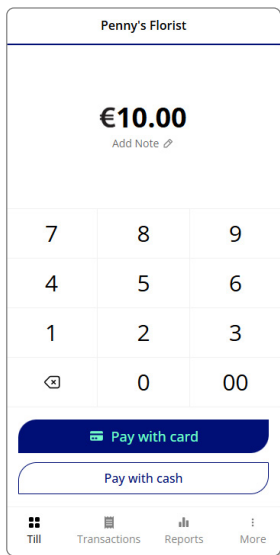
3 Use the keypad to enter the amount of cash paid. You will be prompted onscreen for the amount of change due.

4 Tap "Pay Now".

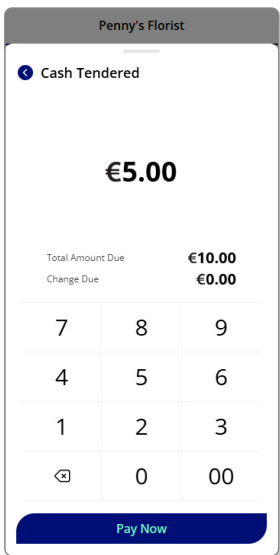


5 your terminal app will now prompt with options to email, SMS, print, or skip the purchase receipt.

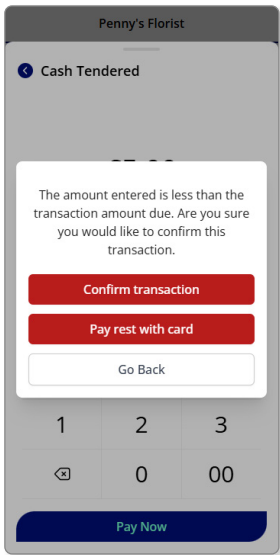
Completing a part Cash/Card payment

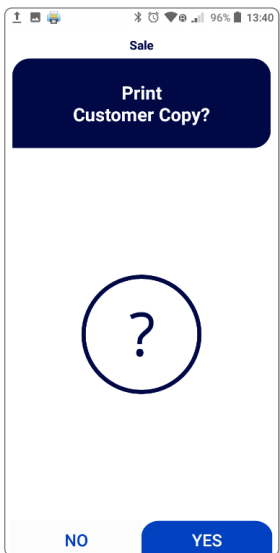

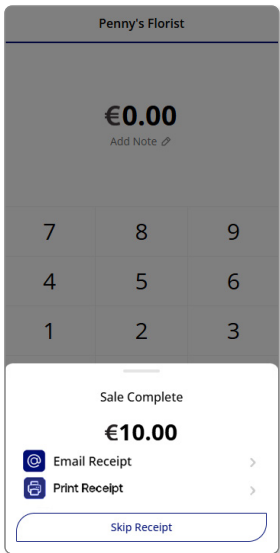

The remaining amount will now appear for card payment. When prompted, present the terminal to the customer to tap for contactless, or insert for Chip & PIN.

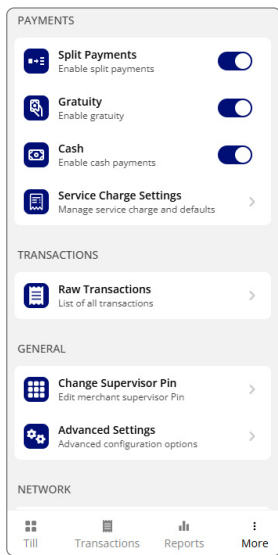
If card receipt printing is enabled in your your terminal app's "More" settings, you will now be prompted with an option to print your cardholder and merchant receipts.

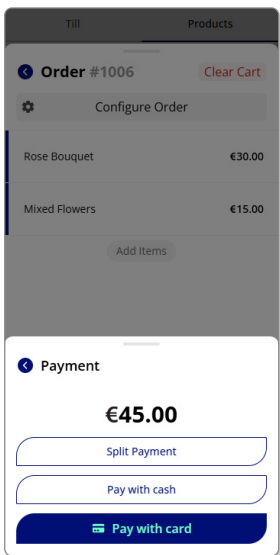

Split payments



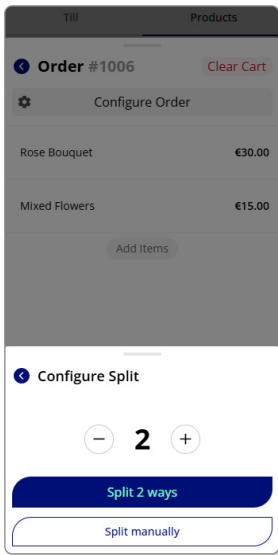

To enable split payments, head to the "More" tab and switch on the toggle.

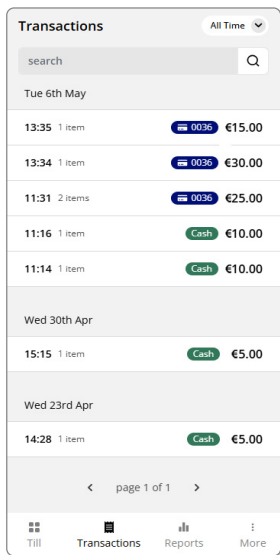
With this enabled, when taking a payment you will be prompted with the option.

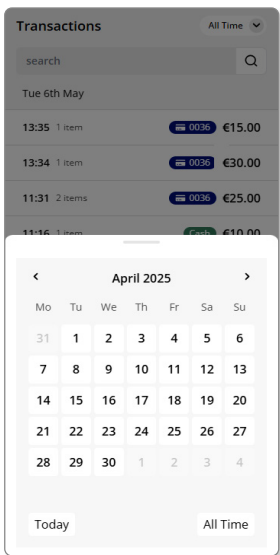
Enter how many ways the customer would like to split and then proceed to taking the payment. You can also select "Split manually" to choose different values.

Viewing Transactions



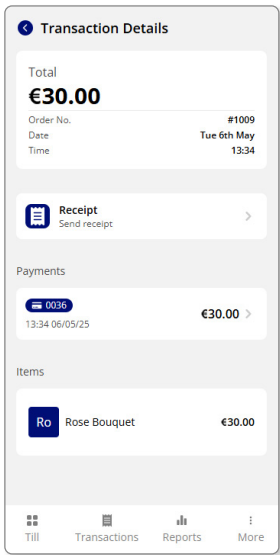

Tap the “Transactions” tab at the bottom.

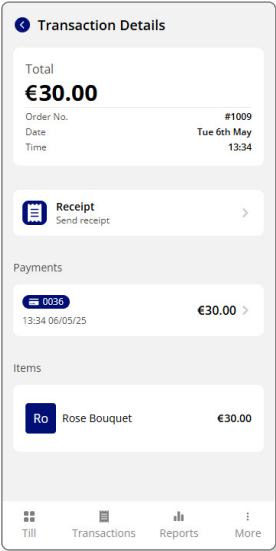
To locate a transaction, either scroll down the screen or use the calendar accessible from the drop down in the top right to select a date.

Once located, tap the transaction to view more details.

Receipt Copies



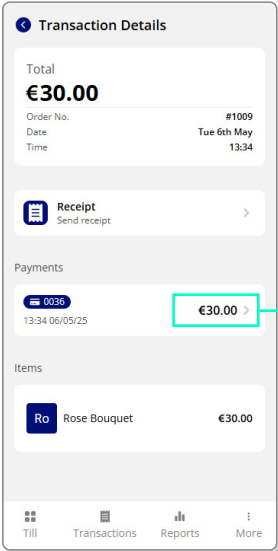
1 Tap “Receipt” to be presented with your receipt delivery options.

2 Tap “Email Receipt” followed by the email address to send a copy of the transaction receipt by email.

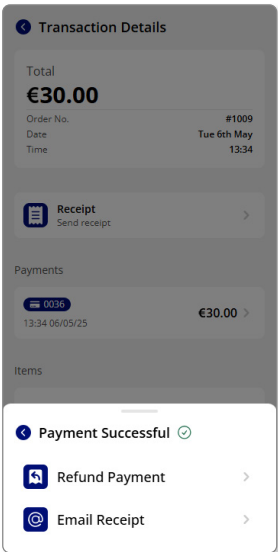
3 Tap “SMS Receipt” followed by the phone number to send a copy of the transaction receipt by SMS.

4 Tap “Print Receipt” to print a copy of the transaction receipt.

Refund a payment

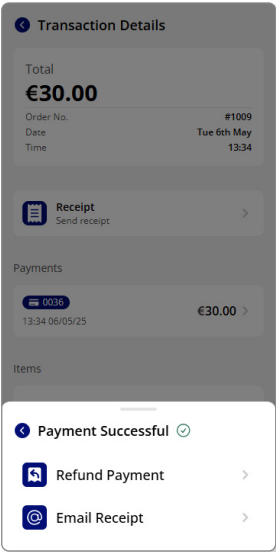


1 Tap the payment associated to the transaction you need to refund (in full or part).

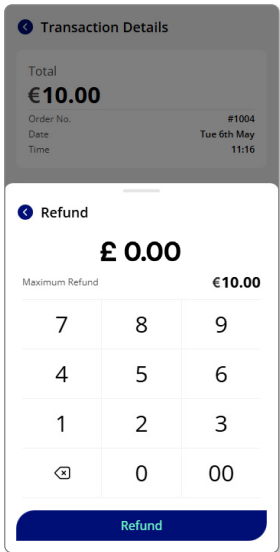


2 Tap “Refund Payment” which will show a lock symbol, and unlock by entering the supervisor PIN.

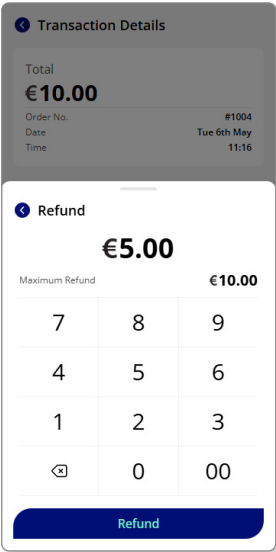

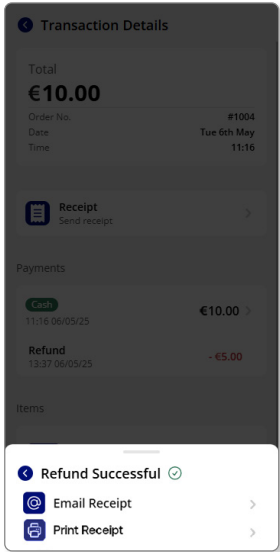
3 Tap “Refund Payment”.



4 Enter using the onscreen keypad the amount to refund (note you cannot refund more than the maximum amount shown onscreen).



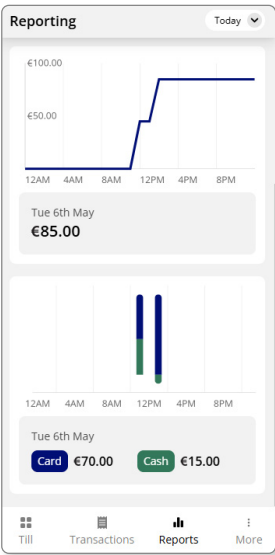
5 Tap “Refund”.



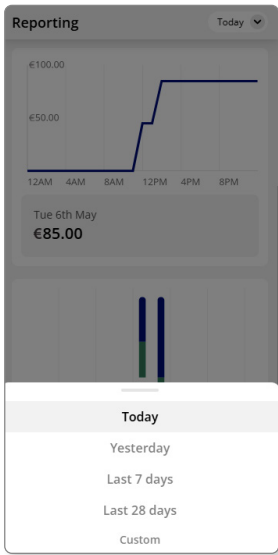
6 If the payment was a cash payment, you will see the refund is successful and the refunded transaction recorded. If the payment was a card payment, you will be taken to the payment screen to process the refund.

Key Statistics

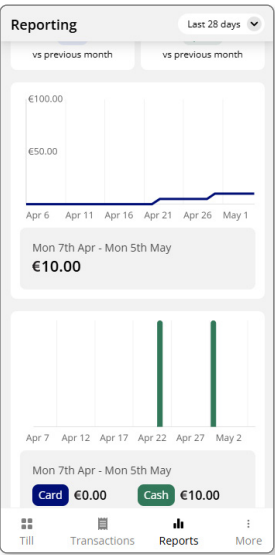
Your terminal app has inbuilt reports to help you see at a glance how your business is running. Tap the “Reports” tab to access this.



At the top of the screen you will be presented with 4 key statistics. These are revenue, transactions (sales), average spend and percentage of payments by card.



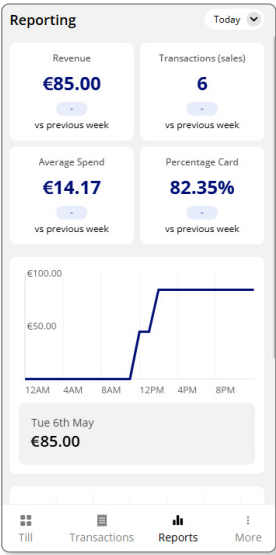
To change the time period, select the drop down in the top right and select from the periods available, or “Custom” to pick a particular date.



The statistics will now update automatically.

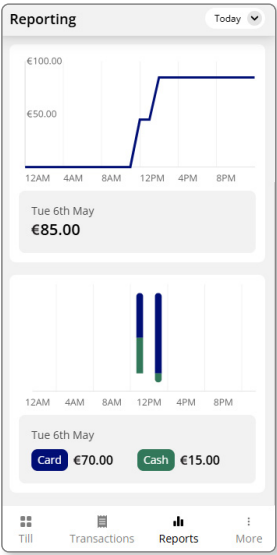
Pro Tip – Beneath each statistic, will be a % difference on the previous period. For example, if you select “Yesterday” as your time period, you will see the % difference vs the previous day.

Revenue Graph



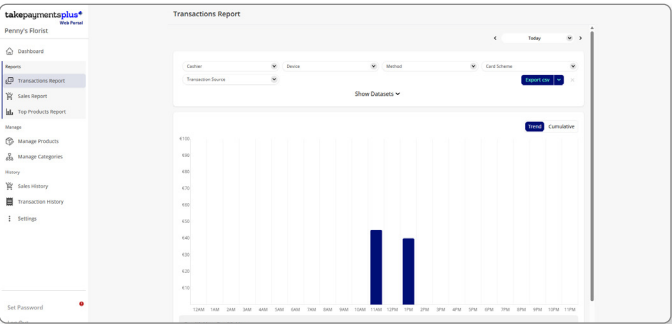
The revenue graph will show you, for the time period selected, your sales revenue in that period. You can tap to interact with the graph to see the revenue in Euros (€) beneath the graph.

Cash/Card Graph



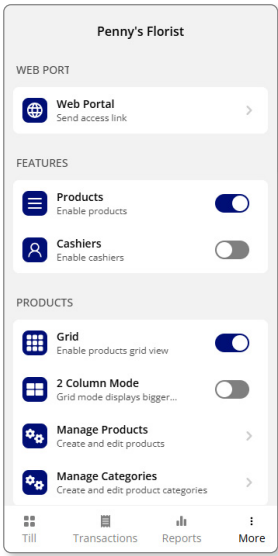
Scrolling to the bottom of the reports tab, you will find a graph showing you the cash vs card split for the time period selected. Again you can tap to interact with the graph and view the split for the time/day you tap.

You can now split reporting by terminal and MID in the Web Portal. To view this, tap on the drop down menu next to "Device" and select your device.



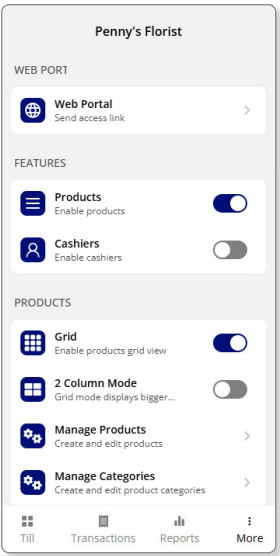
Configuring your Terminal App

The “More” Tab



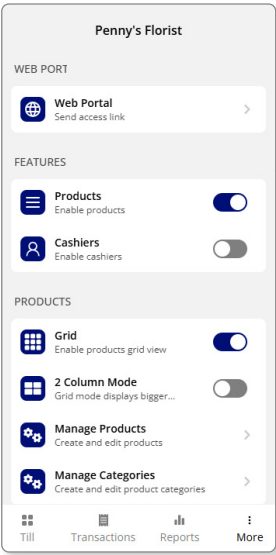
Within this tab you will see a variety of options related to your terminal app. Here you can control the features of your devices, enabling/disabling features and configuring settings.

Portal -> Portal



The “Web Portal” option enables you to send an email to the email addresses registered to your account. This email will contain a link to your online portal, where you can access even more reporting and controls for your your terminal app.

Mode -> Products

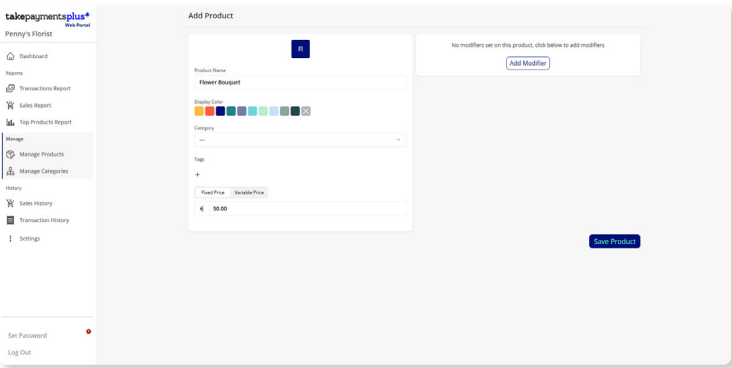


The “Products” switch allows you to enable products on your app. By enabling this feature, further options will appear on the ‘More’ screen and products will also be enabled on your “Till” tab.

The ‘Cashiers’ toggle allows you to add multiple users on your app. By enabling this, you can add new cashiers, remove old ones and edit their names.

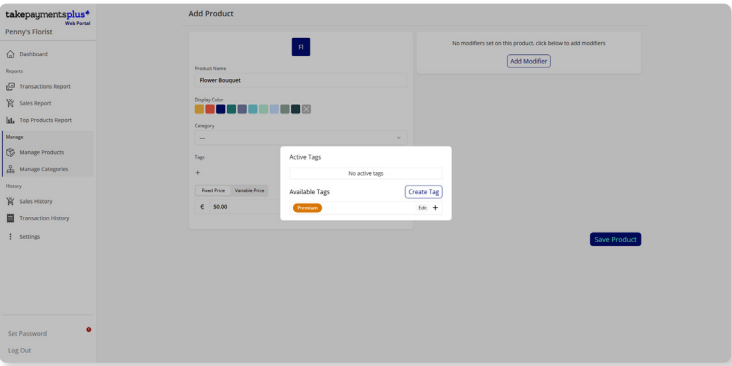
Mode -> Product tagging

Product tagging lets you mark products as 'vegan', 'contains nuts', 'dairy-free', etc. You can add these tags from the **Web Portal**.

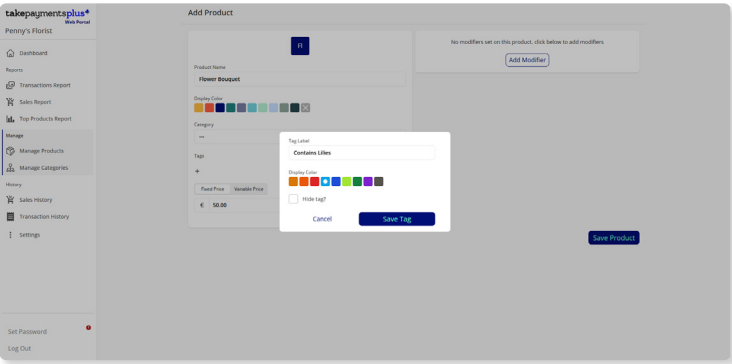
Tap "Manage Products" to find and edit a product.

Under "Tags" tap the "+" icon and create a new tag.

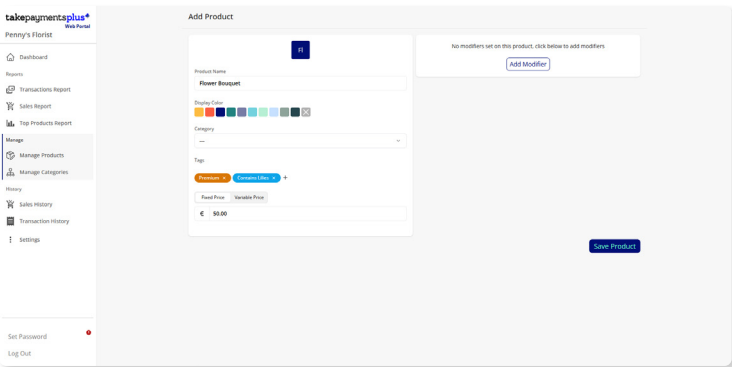

Save the tag and it will apply to the product. Click "Save Product" to finish.

Mode -> Product modifiers

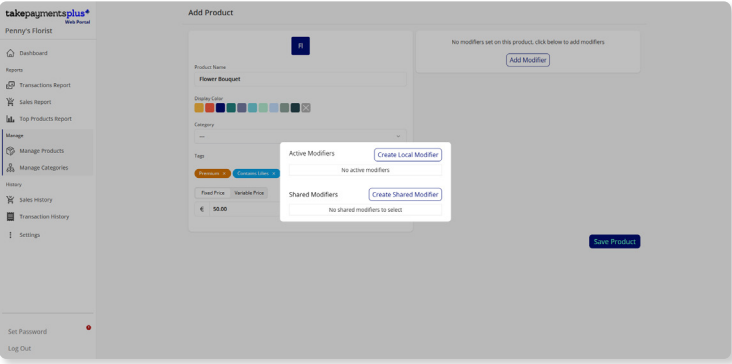
Product modifiers let you add extras to an item and can be created in the Web Portal. There are two types of modifiers: active and shared. Active modifiers are specific to a product and shared can be used across all products.

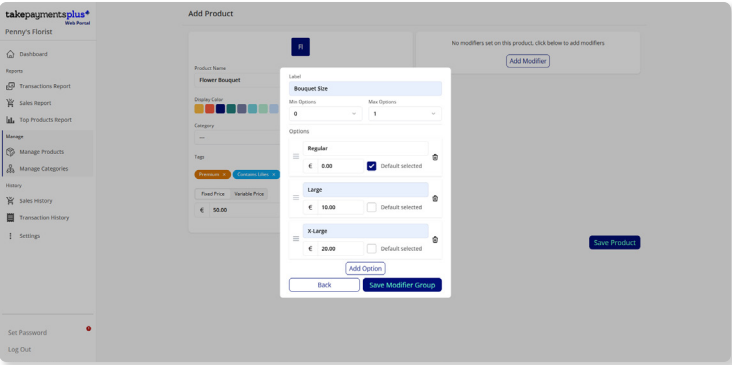
Navigate to "Manage Products" on the web portal and tap on Add "Modifier on the right-hand side.

Mode -> Product modifiers (continued)

You can add an existing modifier or create a new one. Tap either "Create Local Modifier" or "Create Shared Modifier" in the pop up box.

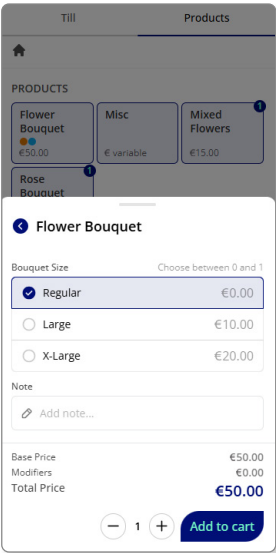

If creating a new one, you'll be prompted to give it a label and set minimum and maximum amounts.

Tap "Save Modifier Group" to finish.

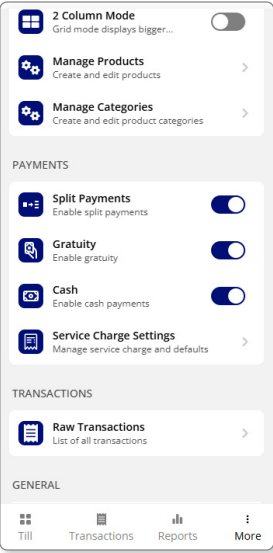
Mode -> Product modifiers (continued)

To add a modifier to an order, a pop up will appear when adding items to the order. Tap on a modifier and this will be added to the bill.

Payments- > Gratuity

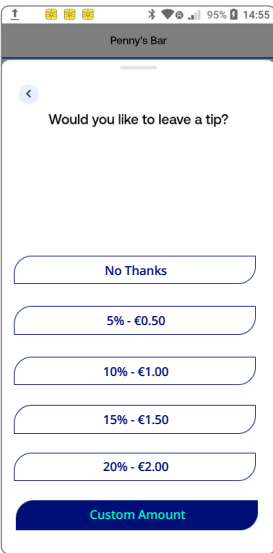


The Gratuity option enables gratuity upon payment on your terminal app. With this option enabled, when processing a cash or card sale the device will prompt for gratuity.

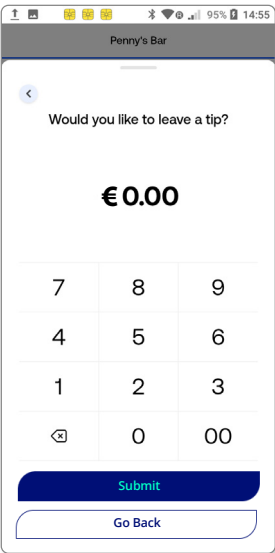
The customer can select from a list of pre-set percentages, enter a custom amount, or “No thanks” to continue without gratuity.

The gratuity payment is then automatically added to the total purchase amount.

With Gratuity enabled, when processing a card or cash sale, your terminal app will prompt for a tip. The terminal can be passed to the customer to confirm the tip amount.



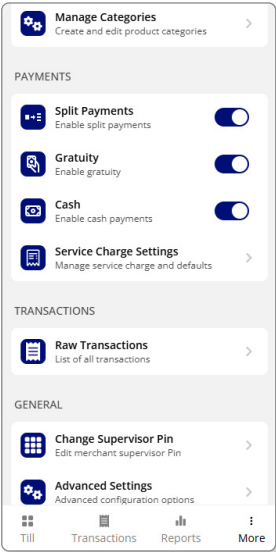
1 Before payment is completed, a prompt will appear stating “Would you like to leave a tip?”. Pass the terminal to the customer to confirm.



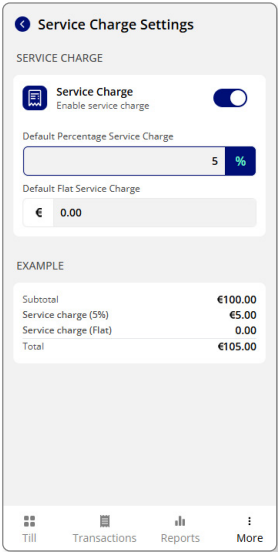
2 The customer can tap “No thanks”, a pre-set of 5% to 20% or to enter a custom amount.

a. If entering a custom amount, the customer will need to use the keypad when prompted to enter the tip to pay.

Payments -> Service Charge

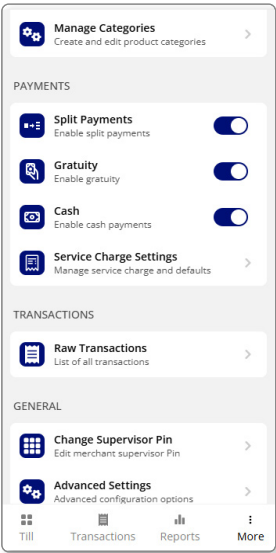

In the "More" tab under "Payment settings", tap 'Service charge settings'.



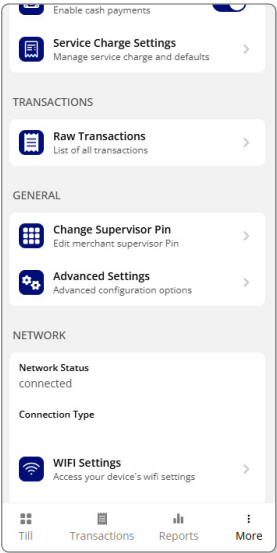

Toggle on the "Service Charge" option and set the amount, this can be either a value or a percentage.
When enabled, this will automatically appear on every transaction when making a payment.

Payments -> Cash



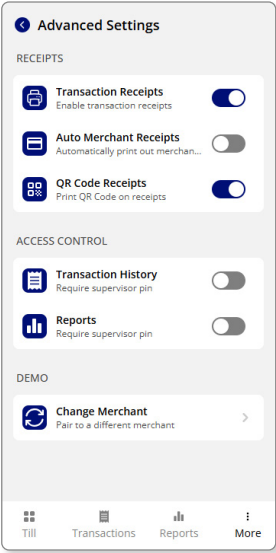
By default your terminal app will be configured to allow you to process cash payments. This switch allows you to enable/disable the cash option on your payment screens.

General -> Change Supervisor PIN



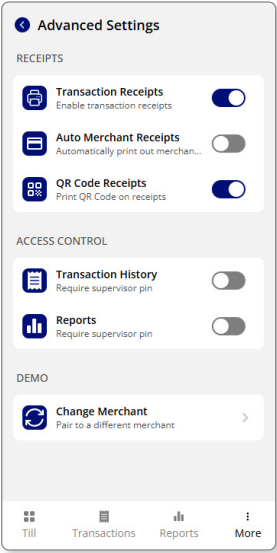
1. To change your supervisor PIN, tap "Change Supervisor PIN".
2. When prompted, enter your current supervisor PIN.
3. Enter your new supervisor PIN, followed by re-entry to confirm.

General -> Advanced Settings



To access advanced settings, tap “Advanced Settings” and when prompted enter your supervisor PIN.

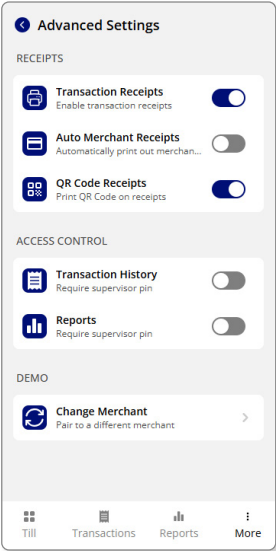
General -> Advanced Settings -> Receipts
-> Transaction Receipts



The “Transaction Receipts” option gives you the ability to enable/ disable the option at the end of a transaction which allows you to email, SMS or print a transaction receipt for your customer.

This can be toggled on if you’d like to automatically issue a merchant copy without being prompted at the end of a transaction.’

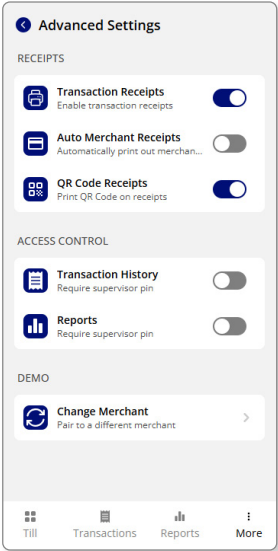
General -> Advanced Settings ->
Receipts -> Card Receipts



The “Card Receipts” option gives you the ability to enable/disable your terminal from prompting for card payment, Cardholder and Merchant copy receipts. With this option enabled, after a card payment is completed your terminal will prompt for the cardholder receipt to be printed, and for a merchant copy to be printed.

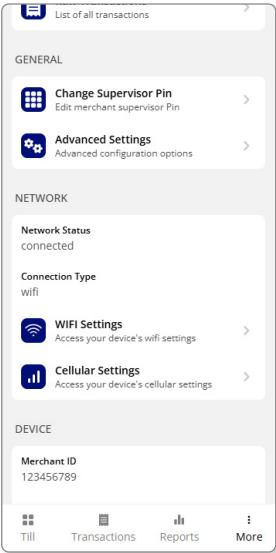
With this option disabled, your terminal will not prompt for the cardholder or merchant receipts.

General -> Advanced Settings ->
Access Control -> Transaction History/Reports



Your terminal app allows you to restrict access to your transactions and reports tabs. Simply enable the “Transaction History” or “Reports” option in your advanced settings to restrict access by supervisor PIN to the Transactions and Reports tabs. Simply disable to allow all users to access these tabs.

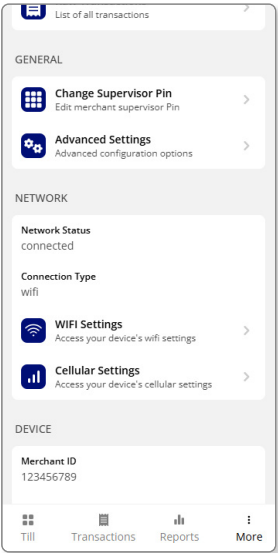
Network



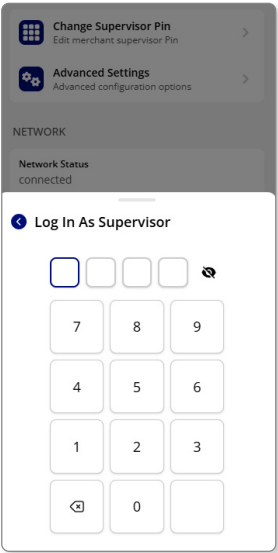
If you need to check how your device is connected, the “Network” section will show you the current network status (connected/disconnected) and connection type (WiFi/ Cellular).

Within this section, you can access the WiFi and Cellular settings directly by tapping the associated option.

Network – Connecting to WiFi

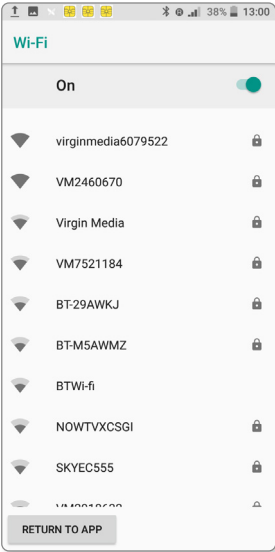


1 Tap “WiFi Settings”.

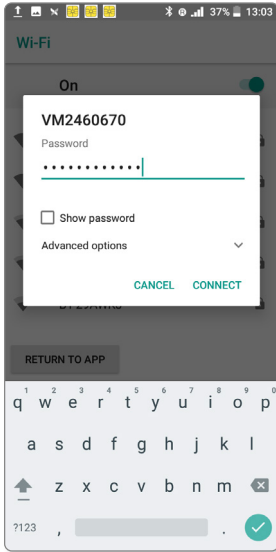


2 Enter the supervisor PIN when prompted.

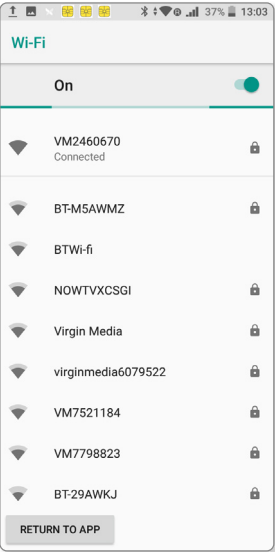

Device



This section provides you basic information on your terminal, which is useful if you require technical support and to contact Bank of Ireland.

In this section is also options to print various reports.

Device -> End of day report

Your end of day report is available for you to print at any time during your day. This will provide a simple print out of both cash and card transaction counts and amounts, refunds, and breakdown of gratuity.

Device -> Card X Report

Your Card X report is an “end of shift” report that will provide a print out of the card sales completed so far, since the last end of day.

Tap “Card X Report” and this will be printed from the terminal.

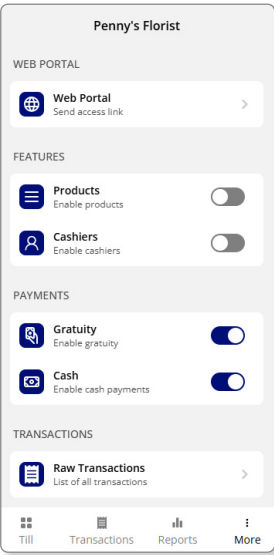
Device -> Card Z Report

Your Card Z report is an “end of day” report that and helps you to reconcile the card payments completed since the last Z report.

Tap “Card Z Report” and this will be printed from the terminal.

Products Mode - Enabling & Configuring

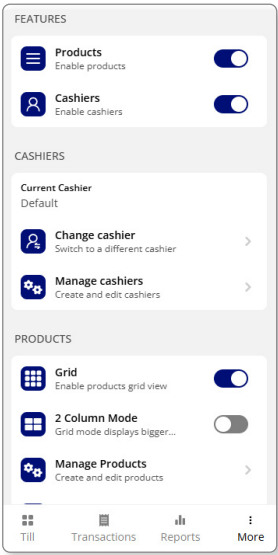
Your terminal app comes ready for you to load on your products, categories, and cashiers. To enable this mode:



1 Tap the "More" tab.

2 Tap the "Products" switch under "Mode".

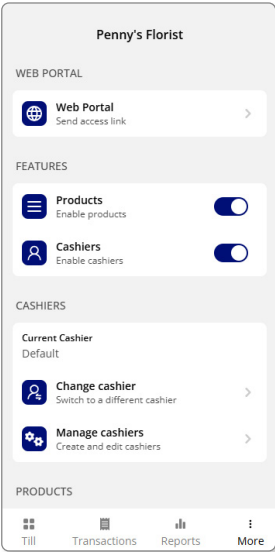
3 Enter your Supervisor PIN when prompted.



4 The Products switch will now be enabled.

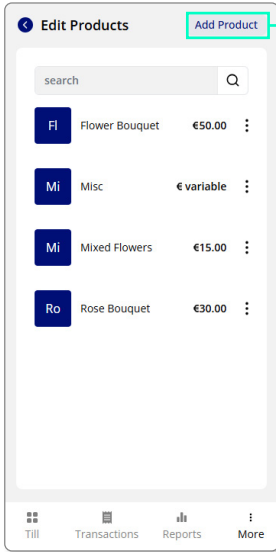

Product Mode – Adding an item



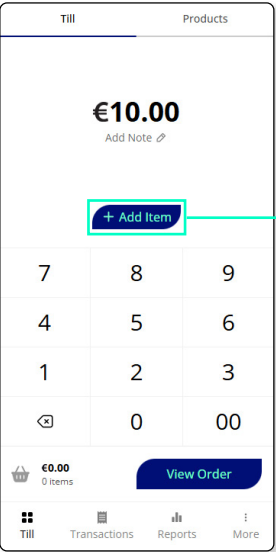
If you need to process a sale for a product you have not yet added to your terminal app, you can use the “Add item” feature on the till.

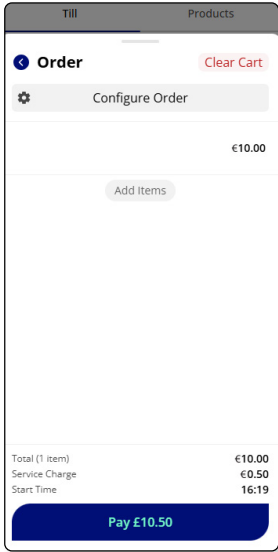
From the “Till” tab, start by using the number pad to enter the item cost.

- a. **Pro Tip – you can enter a note against this item which is displayed in the checkout and on the receipt.**

First enter the amount of the item to be added. Then tap “Add item” and repeat this step for any further items you need to add.

Once complete, tap “Checkout” to review the items to be purchased and paid for.

Product Mode – Adding an item (continued)

4. From this screen, you can increase/decrease the item quantities and delete from the checkout if required.
 - a. **Pro Tip – if you need to start again, tap “Clear cart” in the top right to empty the checkout and start again.**
5. Once ready to complete the purchase, tap “Pay with card” or “Pay with cash” to complete the sale. You can refer back to Page 3 on how to complete these steps.
