### Opening the Conversation

### What is it?

The QuickTalker Freestyle is a speech-generating device that gives [child’s name] the power to communicate in the way that works best for [him/her/them]. What’s really great about this particular device is that we can customize it completely to [child’s name]’s needs and preferences.

This device is typically covered by medical insurance. The first step is to submit an insurance benefit check to see if this is an option through your insurance. You won’t be navigating this process alone.

The process is pretty straightforward. Once the benefit check is submitted, AbleNet will reach directly out to you to gather needed information. Then, they’ll send the device right to you for [child’s name] to try.
