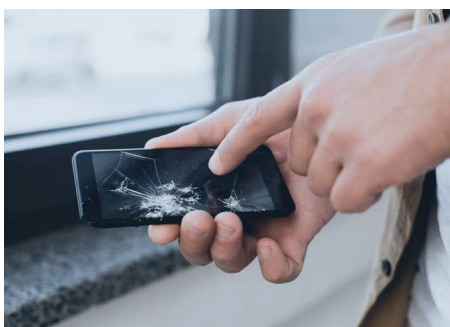


Extended Battery Life
