OVERVIEW

OBJECTIVE	The fund seeks capital appreciation and current income.						
STRATEGY	The fund's sub-adviser, Goldman Sachs, follows an investment process that involves longer-term portfolio positioning through strategic asset allocation and dynamic asset allocation to pursue shorter-term opportunities based on the sub-adviser's views of current market conditions.						
MANAGEMENT	The fund's investment manager, Transamerica Asset Management, Inc., has chosen Goldman Sachs to serve as sub-adviser to the fund.						
SELECTING UNDERLYING FUNDS	The fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing its assets primarily in a broad mix of Transamerica funds and up to 10% in unaffiliated exchange-traded funds. Under normal circumstances, investments in underlying funds are expected to achieve a mix of approximately 50% of net assets in equities and 50% of net assets in fixed income securities. The sub-adviser determines which underlying funds it wishes to utilize to allocate the fund's assets. Allocation among the underlying funds is based on factors such as diversification, general market views and outlooks, volatility in the equity markets, historical performance, current valuations, and other global economic factors.


