Prospr 500 offers a cost-efficient indexing approach designed specifically for 401k plan sponsors and participants seeking investment solutions that provide the ability to have influence over company practices. Price/earnings (P/E) is the valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings. The price-to-sales (P/S) ratio is a valuation ratio that compares a company's stock price to its revenues. The price-to-cash flow (P/CF) ratio is a stock valuation indicator or multiple that measures the value of a stock's price relative to its operating cash flow per share. A company's price-to-book (P/B) ratio is the company's current stock price per share divided by its book value per share. This shows the market valuation of a company compared to its book value.
