The most common botanical name for the snake plant, formerly *Sansevieria trifasciata*, is now *Dracaena trifasciata*. It is native to the rocky, dry tropical regions of West and West Central Africa, ranging from Nigeria east to the Congo. It thrives in low-water, low-light environments, making it a highly resilient, drought-tolerant.



LIGHT

Low to medium indirect light



WATER

Average water needs, can be on the drier side between waterings



FERTILIZER

Feed once per month at half strength when plant is actively growing in spring and summer. When days get shorter, reduce fertilizer and water.

GROWTH

Very slow growing, erect clumps
