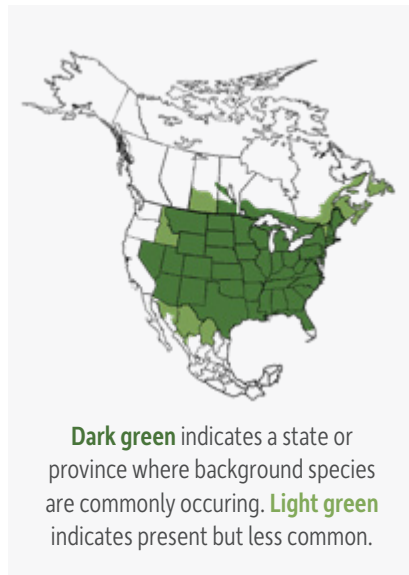
The goal of such hybrids is to preserve the beauty and benefits of the plant as they occur in nature and pair it with the superior performance necessary to thrive in the garden of today's homeowner.

When to only plant Native Species

Native hybrids are not meant to replace native species. In restoration projects, naturalistic plantings, and in spaces where you are trying to establish a self-sustaining plant colony, the native species is often preferable.

Benefits of Native Hybrids

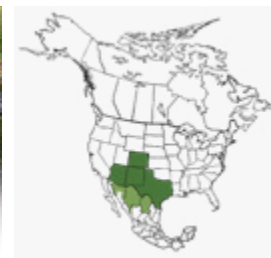
The result of mixing species often brings the best of both worlds. That may be finding additional cold hardiness for a tender perennial, or adding heat and drought tolerance. Native hybrids are often selected for increased blooms which benefit pollinators, sturdier habits for better garden performance, and improved disease resistance.

Taller Yarrow nature with beautiful habits and exceptional sturdiness. Hybrid of native and non native species.

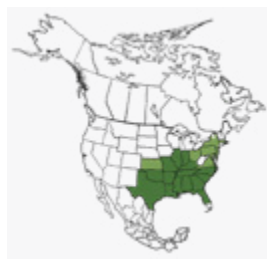
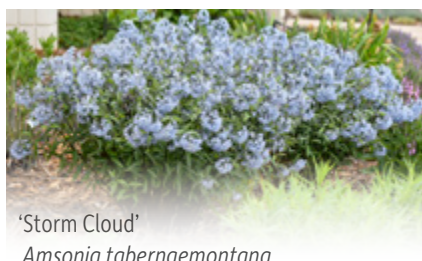

Large, full plants with substantial landscape presence and hardiness. A favorite of pollinators.

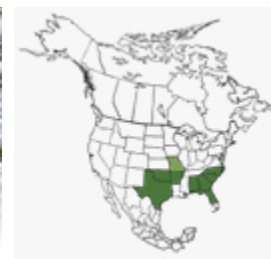

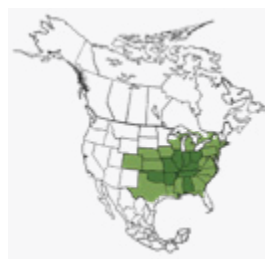

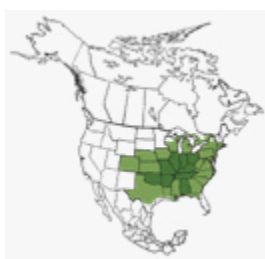

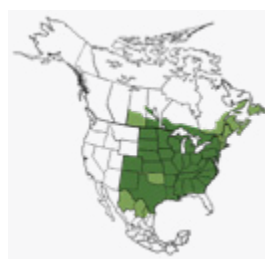

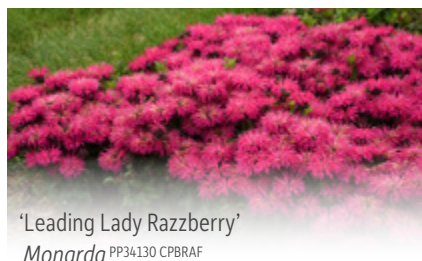

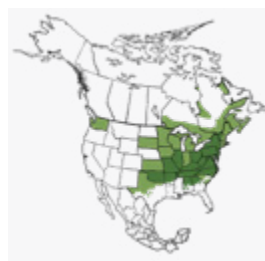

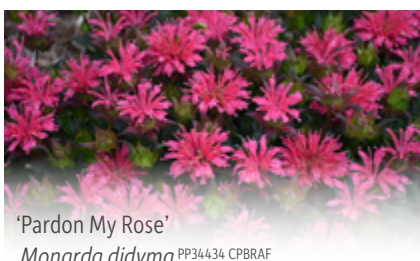

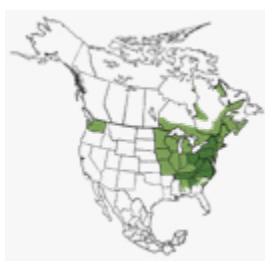

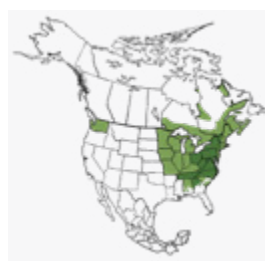

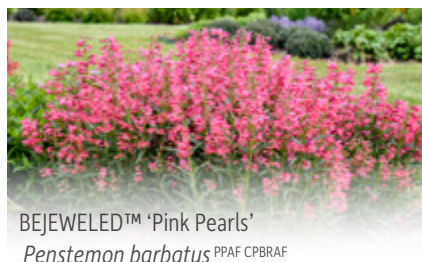

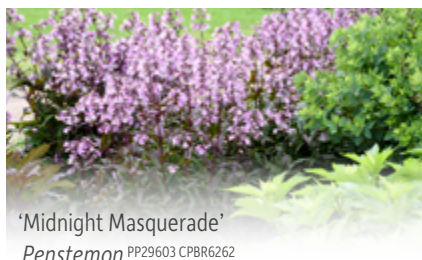

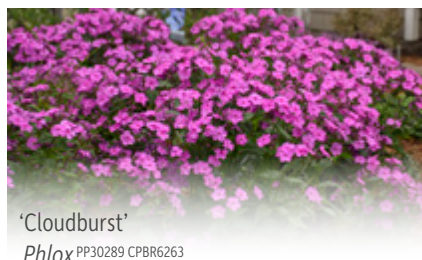

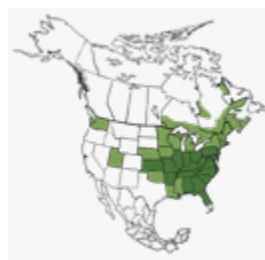

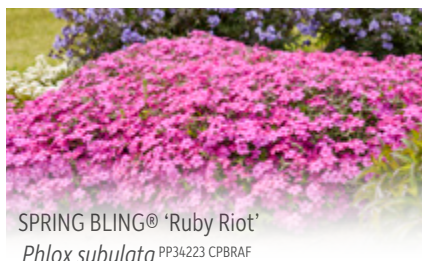

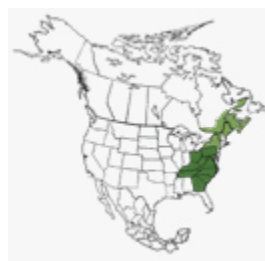

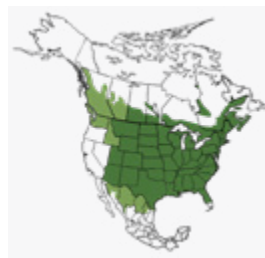

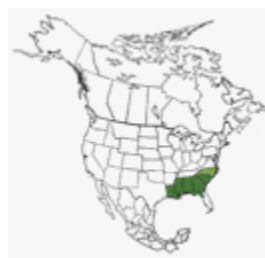
