Economic Outlook

Positives

- Strong U.S. growth in 1H 2021
 - Real gross domestic product (GDP) increased at 6.6% in Q2 2021

Employment continues to recover

- +50K new private sector jobs in Ohio through July
- Increasing labor force participation
 - 60.5% in July (up from 60.2% in June)
- Healthcare
 - Pent-up demand, numerous providers ramping investment

Risk Factors

- Virus resurgence
 - 61%+ of eligible population vaccinated
- Falling CEO and Consumer Confidence
 - Growing concerns (COVID spikes, supply chains, worker shortages)
- Attracting workers
- Over 10M openings nationally
- Run-up in inflation
- Elevated readings well above 2% objective
