Who Should Apply?

To be eligible, your business must be:

 At least 51% minority-owned, woman-owned, veteran-owned, or owned by an individual with a disability.

And/Or:

• Located in an eligible zip code. Eligible zip codes can be found on the JobsOhio website.

Additional Eligibility Critera:

- Annual revenues are between \$100,000 and \$25 million.
- Receive a portion of sales from B2B transactions.
- Operate within one of JobsOhio's 10 target industries.
- At least one year of operating history.
- Retail operations and most professional services are not eligible.
