



Innovation Districts

Three key Innovation Districts establish Ohio as a global leader in healthcare, life sciences, and technology.

JobsOhio is investing \$300 million to fuel the creation of three world-class Innovation Districts in Cincinnati, Cleveland, and Columbus. The goal is to create sustainable ecosystems of ideas, infrastructure, and talent where the world's top people and companies come to roll up their sleeves, innovate, and grow.
