Harford County, Maryland has been a client since 2013. Our services are focused on financial advisory services. Since 1996, the County had been increasing its rates based on CPI leading to a looming financial deficit. We integrated eight distinct work items into a holistic framework, developed a pragmatic five-year financial plan and cost of service-based rate schedules. With our recommendations, the County successfully implemented its first-ever five-year financial plan for fiscal year (FY) 2016 through 2020.

We continued to provide services to the County and helped to develop their next five-year financial plan for the forecast period of FY 2021 through FY 2025. In these studies, our consultants developed and delivered a robust and user-friendly rate model with financial planning, cost of service, rate design, and capacity fee analysis modules.
