Varn Enviroflex Aquawash is a good all round flexographic cleaner designed to work alongside all ancillary pressroom cleaning equipment. It can be dosed direct into automated press wash down systems, ancillary plate wash down systems, bucket wash systems, pressroom cleaning tanks and automated floor cleaning machines.

Application:

- Varn Enviroflex Aquawash can be pumped or circulated through the entire ink metering systems.
- Varn Enviroflex Aquawash may be applied with a sponge, cloth, brush, pad or sprayer.
- Allow the product to remain for a few minutes, scrub then wipe away and flush the surface then dry with a clean cloth.
- Varn Enviroflex Aquawash should be used diluted down to the optimum concentration by hand or via a dosing system.
- Use at 1:9 dilution for general cleaning.
- For optimum performance, use in conjunction with the Varn Enviroflex Pad.
