- Coldset spray dampening presses. Use 2-4 ounces per gallon of water. Conductivity per ounce above water 510-520 micromhos. Increase product by ½ ounce per gallon as needed to achieve desired print quality. For best results start with a clean dampening system.

 - Controls tinting and toning
 - Zero VOC design is less aggressive to coldset inks
