



Introducing Church Pharmacy who use automation to reduce errors, costs and wait times and enable pharmacists to concentrate on providing accurate services. The award-winning pharmaceutical supplier for clinics and hospitals in the United Kingdom was growing fast and needed to rethink operations to keep pace. For Church Pharmacy accuracy is at the forefront and customer service is a top priority. It was time to improve overall picking processes and optimize space with the challenge of implementing the changes while staying in the same location.

Working with Kardex, Church Pharmacy transitioned its facility to a modern warehouse with significant improvements such as increasing batch speeds and reducing staff training. The teams focused on accuracy and compliance to implement a fully-integrated intralogistics solution. By implementing automation, Church Pharmacy added space and increased efficiencies across its business.

Main challenges

Church Pharmacy, one of the largest suppliers of medical aesthetics and pharmaceutical products to healthcare professionals in the United Kingdom, was growing faster than its warehouse could manage. The demands on staff and the incumbent storage infrastructure were becoming potential issues. A high-spec warehouse designed to promote cleanliness and safety meant that they needed to optimize the warehouse rather than move to larger premises.

Working with the technical team at UpSTEAM.uk, Church Pharmacy analyzed its business processes. An automated solution was required to utilize storage space, improve accuracy at the pick process stage and enable staff to dispense correctly picked products, whilst reducing search time/effort. A capacity for scaling-up and ensuring compliance so that the day-to-day customer service was not affected was also a priority.

Automation is the solution

The Church Pharmacy and UpSTEAM.uk teams came together to find the right solution. Recognizing that although space was important, the focus also needed to be on accuracy and productivity. It was clear the best approach for the business was an automated solution and one that was flexible in adapting to complex business processes in a modular fashion. The team chose the VBM and Kardex Frame Pick system as the top match for Church Pharmacy's needs.

The solution offered the capability to have more than one access point for replenishment and retrieval and a laser pointer to easily identify the location of each pick. One major benefit of the VBM is it provides greater flexibility for individual order fulfillment. Additionally, the solution features a turntable, designed for fast order picking. The turntable sits at the front ensuring the next pick is ready in advance.

The VBM's modular design with its small but secure footprint, allows for scalability whilst being able to work alongside other software and hardware solutions, such as the Kardex Frame Pick System. Church Pharmacy was able to stay at its current premises thanks to the Kardex system's ability to store a significant amount of stock in a small footprint.

Accuracy is a must

In the pharmaceutical industry, dispatching the incorrect medication can cause significant risks, making accuracy a main driver. With the VBM, accuracy currently sits at 99.9%. This has made a big difference increasing the team's confidence when picking the correct item to be presented to the pharmacist for the final accuracy check. The pharmacist can now focus more on the clinical patient checks. By eliminating manual picking, the VBM has significantly increased accuracy for Church Pharmacy.

Combining speed with ergonomics

In the past, the manual process meant that the picking team would walk around the warehouse to locate stock for an order. This was then handed to the pharmacists to make sure the items were correct prior to packing/sending. The VBM delivers the exact product required to the picker, meeting the need for more ergonomic working conditions. It also offers the ability to have more than one access point for replenishment and retrieval and a laser pointer to easily identify the location of the pick.

The VBM in combination with the Kardex Frame Pick System means time spent picking has been reduced from approximately 24-man hours a day to 6 hours, resulting in a 75% savings in time whilst improving picking accuracy.

Kardex Frame Pick System for batch picking

The team added the Kardex Frame Pick System to provide an even higher level of flexibility, especially when Church Pharmacy requires additional labor during higher order volumes. The Kardex Frame Pick solution can pick up to a batch of 36 orders simultaneously.

Optical indicators such as pick-to-light and put-to-light direct the operators to the exact location of the pick or put - increasing accuracy and reducing the number of pick errors. As the frame sits 1.5 meters opposite the VBM terminal where products are being presented, the walking distance between the presentations and orders dramatically decreased.

The single terminal used for batch picking presentations reduces the amount of walking and increases the size of the batches that can be picked using a frame.



Smart software brings it together

The Kardex Power Pick System navigates the orders through part of the fulfillment process. The Kardex Power Pick System also facilitates the batch picking which enables Church Pharmacy's staff to fulfill multiple orders at the same time. The storage rules allow for maximum volume to be utilized whilst also allowing to batch pick from static racking. Each material can also be customized by using features such as lot, expiry, serialization and kit.

The Kardex Power Pick System software integrated with the flexible Batch-Master3000 batching and fulfillment tool designed by UpSTEAM.uk helps increase picking speeds and efficiency by another 35 – 40% which ensures all stocked items are delivered on-time, in prioritized order, for efficient picking whilst delivering a tailored solution based on the material process and fulfillment flow.

When required, the Kardex Power Pick System communicates with various peripheral devices such as bar code scanners, batch lights, laser light pointers, printers, etc.

Installation = business as usual

It took a matter of 6 weeks to have everything fully operational, including the software installation, but as with any installation there are always teething issues that occur. These were mitigated by ensuring that the Kardex and UpSTEAM.uk teams worked closely together to ensure the launch of each phase, taking into account, the importance of business continuity of order processing. Kardex worked with Church Pharmacy to make sure the project was completed to their satisfaction.

Exceeding expectations

An unforeseen benefit was in regards to training. Normally staff would require a minimum training of one month on the goods in and picking processes. Now staff are trained within a week. Being able to stay in its high-spec warehouse has delivered significant savings and Church Pharmacy predicts an ROI in less than 2 years. The Kardex Power Pick System now manages Church Pharmacy's multiple pharmacy branches and warehouses including its racked and refrigerated stock.
