

Automating Intralogistics

Implimenting goods to person automation into your intralogistics operations can:

01 Improve replenishment



Workers can be notified when replenishment is needed and are quickly directed to the replenishment location.

02 Eliminate travel time



Parts are delivered directly to the worker allowing more time for picking and eliminating the travel time required in a manual system.

03 Reduce search time



Using pick to light technology the worker is immediately directed to the part instead of spending time visually searching shelves.

04 Minimize pick errors



In coordination with inventory management software and pick-to-light, workers can achieve 99.9% accuracy rates.

05 Increase throughput



Workers can increase throughput (up to 400 lines / hour) compared manual systems (averaging 50 lines / hour).

06 Enhance inventory protection



An enclosed automated system keeps inventory protected from dirt and dust – extending its useful life.

07 Reduce missing inventory



Using inventory management software, inventory levels can be accurately monitored in real time.

08 Increase product security



Inventory is securely stored in an enclosed system and worker access can be limited based on system log in credentials.

09 Optimize storage space



Utilizing floor to ceiling height, inventory can be managed in a compact footprint, saving up to 85% previously occupied floor space.

10 Provide better ergonomics



All inventory is delivered directly to the worker at an ergonomically positioned access point.
