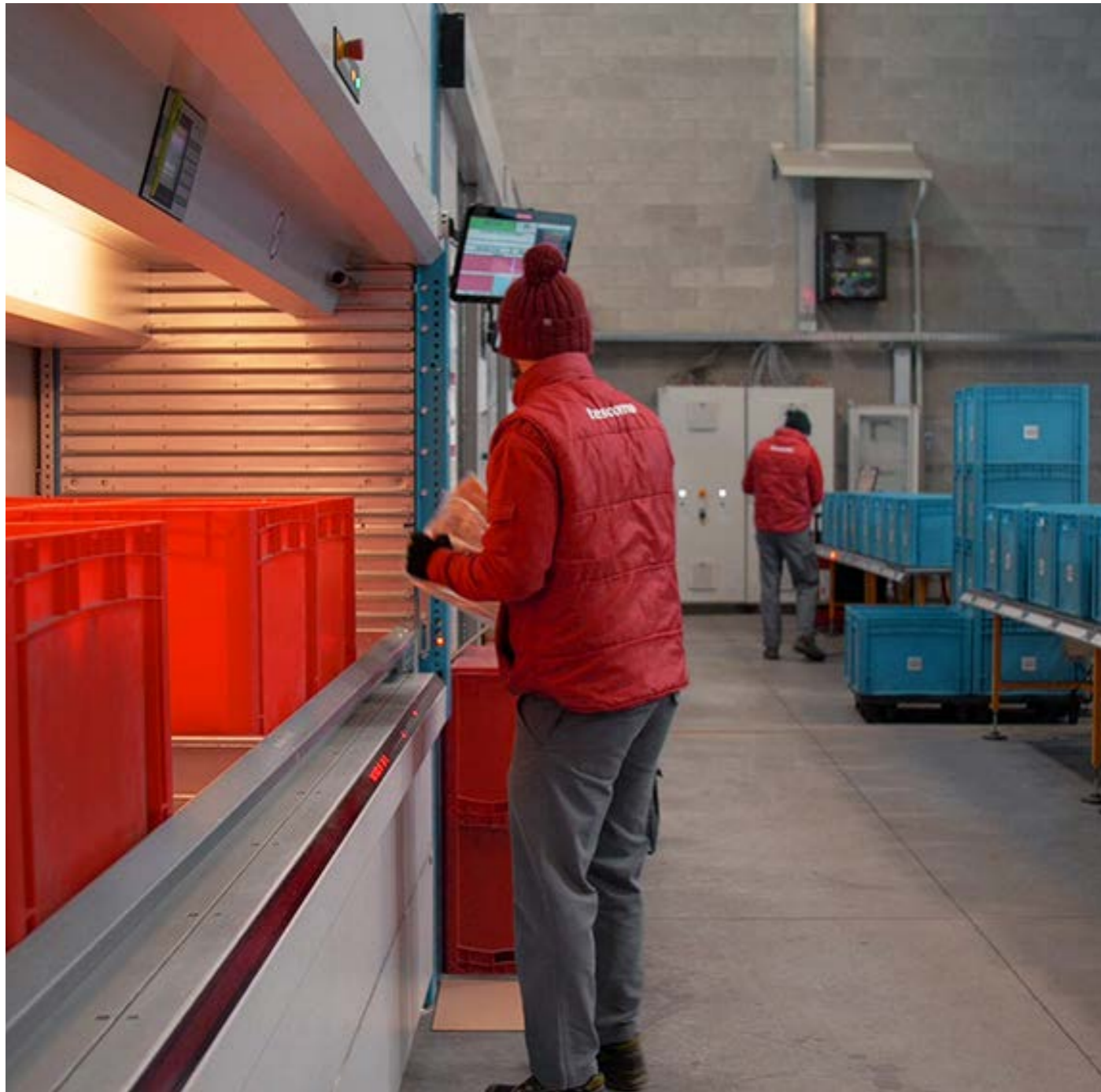

Order Picking and Consolidation





Pick and put away optimization

Customer and task

Based in Italy, Tescoma's 11,000 m² logistics center manages an inventory of approximately 2,600 SKUs. Tescoma commissioned Kardex to optimize its processes for both order preparation and execution. They wanted to provide the e-commerce and retail channels with faster delivery capabilities. This would ultimately result in added value for Tescoma customers.

Tescoma manages various order types, ranging from one to 150 order lines, with approximately 15,500 orders annually.

By integrating automated solutions, Kardex has helped Tescoma optimizing the whole order fulfillment processes.

Solution

Orders are picked using five Kardex Horizontal Carousels and one Kardex Shuttle. Put-to-light technology ensures the simultaneous management of multiple orders. The Kardex Miniload-in-a-Box with automated conveyor connection allows the consolidation and sequencing of orders via three exit lines.

The solution enables users to speed up order picking. The Kardex Miniload-in-a-Box consolidates orders, reorganizes floor space and is used as a buffer to manage approximately 500 boxes awaiting shipment.

The Kardex system is incorporated into Tescoma's ERP system and the Warehouse Management System (WMS) uses an integrated process to handle both picking and temporary storage. During the shipping process the order bins are delivered to the operator position through three exit lines.

How we took our customer from task to solution

Tescoma produces its own brand of kitchen utensils sold throughout 130 countries worldwide. In 1996, Tescoma was managing various sized orders for both wholesale and e-commerce from an 11,000m² logistics hub in Italy. To optimize order fulfillment, Kardex created a custom solution for Tescoma. This included five Kardex Horizontal Carousel, one Kardex Shuttle and one Kardex Miniload-in-a-Box.*
