



Fantasy books are fictional stories that have some elements that are not true or cannot happen in this world (talking animals, dragons, fairies, etc.).




Science fiction is a type of fantasy that uses science and technology, often set in the future. Many stories include time machines, robots, and/or aliens.




Historical fictional novels are stories that take place in a particular time period in the past. The settings are generally real, but the characters can be fictional.




Mystery and thriller novels are suspenseful stories about a puzzling event or crime that is not resolved until the end of the story.




In realistic fiction, the characters are fictional, but the events could happen in real life.



Nonfiction books are texts that provide information to a reader. Biographies and autobiographies are considered nonfiction.




Fast-paced action and adventure stories that focus on events filled with danger and physical action to give the reader a sense of excitement.



Dystopian stories set in an imagined universe, usually futuristic, where characters live in a seemingly perfect society but are oppressively controlled.








Romance stories that focus on the relationship and romantic love between two people and have an emotionally satisfying and optimistic ending.
