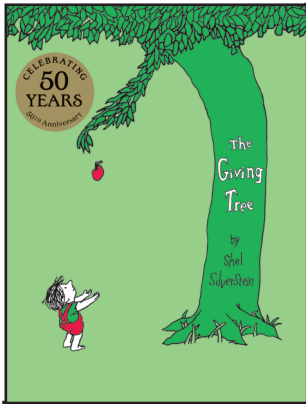
How well do you know *The Giving Tree*? Use the words in the box to fill in the blanks with the beginning lines of the book. Then read aloud to see if you got the story right.

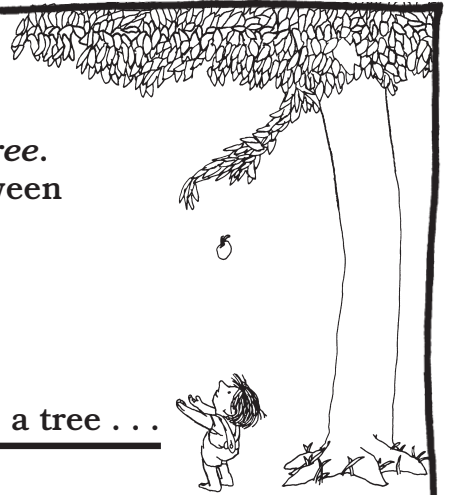

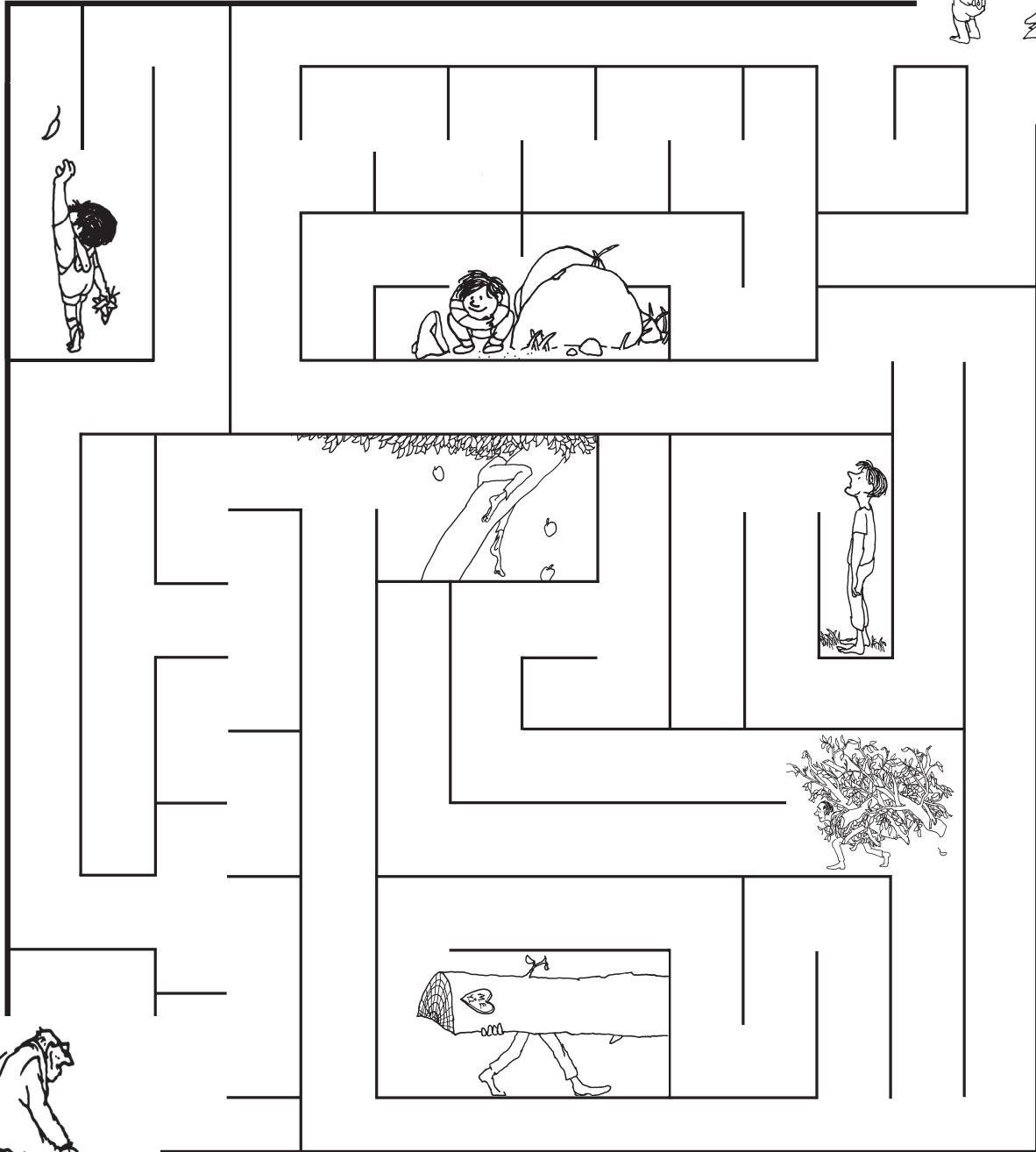
# A Giving Maze
