Broadcast: The Avatar– Part 2

Guest(s): Rabbi Jonathan Cahn

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Dr. James Dobson: Hello everyone. You're listening to Family Talk, the radio broadcasting ministry of the James Dobson Family Institute. I'm Dr. James Dobson, and thank you for joining us for this program.

Roger Marsh: Well, welcome back to Family Talk. I'm Roger Marsh, and on the last edition of our program, we began a fascinating conversation featuring our own Michele Bachman and Rabbi Jonathan Cahn, who's written a brand-new book called *The Avatar: The Return of the Ancients and The Future of America*. During our last conversation, Rabbi Cahn revealed how ancient biblical patterns are playing out in modern American politics from the house of Ahab to the mysterious connections between spiritual forces and recent presidential elections right here in the U.S. On today's edition of Dr. James Dobson's Family Talk, we are continuing that conversation as Rabbi Cahn dives deeper into what he calls the "avatar mystery", exploring the spiritual significance behind names, birth dates, and even the assassination attempt on the life of Donald Trump. Here now is Michele Bachmann with her guest, Rabbi Jonathan Cahn, to continue their conversation on today's edition of Family Talk.

Michele Bachmann: Well, welcome back to James Dobson Family Talk. We are so thrilled that you're here and we are now here for day two with Rabbi Jonathan Cahn. He is talking to us about his new book, which I'm sure will be another best-seller. Just came out. *The Avatar: The Return of the Ancients and the Future of America*. You can buy this book at Amazon or any bookstore in your local community. You know Jonathan Cahn from his book *The Harbinger*, and he's written many, many *New York Times* best-sellers since then. So Jonathan Cahn laid the foundation in yesterday's program, and so now we'll continue on today. Thank you so much, Rabbi, for being with us. Let me open up our show today on *The Avatar*, your latest blockbuster book. What did King Jehu do? He was the righteous king in the Northern Israeli kingdom. What did he do be upon becoming king, and what does it have to do with our current president, Donald Trump?

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah, as we were talking about last time, there's this ancient prototype. It's amazing because Donald Trump is following in this without knowing it, and that's Jehu. And Jehu was wild and Jehu was unpredictable, but Jehu was used by God. It's not about Jehu, it's about God. And so it's not about Trump, it's about God. And the thing is, what he did is he was anointed to strike down the house of Ahab and the American House of Ahab is basically what's been taken over our culture, this anti-biblical agenda that looked like was going to take over

everything and everything changed with the election. And the thing is that, so what Jehu literally did is he purged the government of the House of Ahab. And what has Donald Trump been doing? He's been literally, I mean, the people who hate him say he's purging the government. Also, Jehu took down the temple of Baal or dismantled the temple of Baal, which is used to basically kill children. Well, Donald Trump has been also against abortion. *Roe vs. Wade* has been the American temple of Baal, and he's been dismantling these agencies that have gone against the will of God.

Michele Bachmann: Again, we're not lifting up President Trump as an individual person that we're saying that he is Jehu. What we're saying is that there is a template in Scripture, and it's amazing how identical it is. That's your latest book called *The Avatar: The Return of the Ancients and the Future of America* that people can buy in any bookstore or on Amazon. But I think it's important for our audience, if they missed yesterday's show, and please go back and listen to it again, would you state for our audience again, what is an avatar and who were these God kings, these goddess queens of the pagan world?

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah, the avatar and these beliefs, you didn't just have gods. When you didn't have God, you had gods. I mean, these are spirits and these are false gods, but they're worship. You didn't just have gods, you had avatars. And that is that they believed, in other words, that the people, there'd be people who would serve as vessels of these gods or manifestations or images of the gods. For instance, the Pharaohs of Egypt were considered avatars. They were to be the living embodiments of these gods. So the kings of Babylon all throughout the pagan world, I mean, which goes with the Bible because we're saying behind these gods are spirits, and spirits seek to possess. So what could happen if America has been turning away from God? Okay, you get other things that come in like these gods or the spirits, but could we actually get to the stage where you're dealing with people or you're dealing with a son or people who are in effect acting as avatars, and that's what this is going to reveal.

Michele Bachmann: Well, and that's concerning because the Bible is very bold about who God is. There is no God other than God. It's the first commandment.

Jonathan Cahn: That's right.

Michele Bachmann: God is God. But we also know that Satan is real. He's not a figment of anybody's imagination. The Bible talks about Satan, but it also talks about the fallen angels and the fact that there is a demonic realm. So we're not glorifying Satan, we're not glorifying the demonic realm, but we're saying that this is a reality that we have to deal with. So can you talk to us a little bit? You had gone to India, you talked about that in our last show together, but then also you wrote about it in your book, and there you talked about the House of Brahman, and what does the house of Brahman have to do with avatars?

Jonathan Cahn: Well, the word avatar actually comes from Hinduism and these eastern gods.

Michele Bachmann: So Eastern religions, false religions.

Jonathan Cahn: Yes. And the thing is that the belief among them is that this particular house or lineage called Brahman, these are the priests of the gods, actually the lineage from these come avatars or people who serve as this purpose now from the house of Brahman was born a person that we know as Kamala Harris. She was born of this house of avatars.

Michele Bachmann: Because her mother, her mother was a Hindu.

Jonathan Cahn: Her mother was a Hindu from the family called Gopalan, which is actually named after an avatar. So you got that to start with. And then you have even the mystery of her name.

Michele Bachmann: The mystery of her name. And there were strange similarities between this goddess and Kamala Harris.

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah. When she's born, they give her the name Kamala. Now Kamala, and listen again, it's not about her. She doesn't know what she's doing, but Kamala is actually the name of an ancient goddess, a Hindu goddess. And if you miss that, her middle name is Devi, which means literally the goddess. So her name means Kamala, the goddess. That's the first thing. Secondly, her life follows the pattern of the myth of this goddess. The goddess, Kamala, according to their belief is her birth is linked to the ocean, and her rise is linked to the ocean. Well, Kamala Harris is born by the ocean, the San Francisco Bay. Her rise comes from San Francisco by the ocean, the goddess, Kamala becomes the number two leader in the Hindu pantheon. So Kamala Harris becomes the number two, becomes the vice president. They call Joe Biden, they called him sleepy Joe. Well, the goddess Kamala is joined to the God Vishnu, who's the number one in the Hindu, and he's called the sleeping god. Okay. And in Hinduism, you have the concept. You know how Kamala laughs and she laugh at times it didn't really make sense. Well, in Hinduism, you have the concept of Devi, which is her middle name, which is the laughing goddess. So even that, I mean, there is so much to this, but it's crazily but amazing.

Michele Bachmann: Well, and here in the United States, we're not a Hindu nation. We're a Judeo-Christian nation. We don't really have a strong background or even understanding of Hindu and of these eastern religions and of the demonic realm and the gods that go along with all of that. And that's why when we heard Kamala Harris's name, there was even a question of pronouncing the name. People were castigated if they didn't pronounce it right. And yet we find out through your book that her name, her mother being a Hindu named Kamala Harris for after a goddess and even her sister's name...

Jonathan Cahn: That's right.

Michele Bachmann: Was also the name of another goddess.

Jonathan Cahn: That is right.

Michele Bachmann: In the Pantheon. It was amazing how close it was. And so there was a mystery that you talked about of some of these names that I can't even pronounce.

Jonathan Cahn: Yes. I'll say them. Yeah. Here's the thing. There's a day of the Hindu year where this goddess is worshiped and they put idols in their house. It's called Sharad Purnima. Now, Sharad Purnima fell on October 20th, 1964. Kamala Harris was born on October 20th, 1964, the day of the goddess, Kamala. I mean, she could not have controlled, but she is, let me give you, there's another one, which is crazy to pronounce. It's called Kojagara Puja. This is the night when they believe that the goddess Kamala enters the world under the full moon. Well, Kamala Harris was born at night, and she was born on that same night when she entered the world, when they believe the goddess Kamala enters the world. And the other thing about it, one more thing going deeper is that that was one day in the Hindu year where they celebrate the birth of the goddess, Kamala. Kamala Harris, Kamala, the woman was born on the day of the birth of the goddess, Kamala. And so when she's born, literally when she's born into the world, people all around the world are chanting the name of Kamala. The worshipers are watching and listen, the significance here or the sign of the avatar, this is what it's about, is that as you said it, we were created. We were founded to be a nation to God's glory.

Michele Bachmann: Yes.

Jonathan Cahn: We are one nation under God. But think about this. Think about this as a sign. Because in the ancient world, it's kind of like if these spirits can rule the king, they rule the kingdom. So you have somebody whose name means the goddess who is running for president to lead the land. It would be one nation under the goddess. What a sign. And that's where we were going when you take out God, and that's what we were saved from as well. But these are the stakes that we were dealing with.

Michele Bachmann: Well, and it's incredible how it was really opposite ends of the spectrum, the choices that people were giving. And so we see these avatars, which is a spirit embodiment of a human being. I think that's what you're talking about, that there is a spiritual realm. God. God came to this earth, He humbled himself, and He came to this earth in the form of Jesus, and His Holy Spirit was and continues to be on this earth. And we know that there is a demonic realm, a satanic realm. And so in these false religions, there is a satanic realm. And it's interesting how you have discovered all of these details about that and that even here in America, a choice was given to the American people and one that represented something so opposite from the other. So this mystery goes still one step deeper. Could you talk about that?

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah, this will go into that of the image. I mean, so if we can take this in that, listen, she's named after the goddess, born on the day of the goddess, born on the night of the goddess entering the world, enters the world, and born on the

birth date of the goddess, Kamala, of all things. Nobody could have controlled that. But then there's the image. You see in ancient times when you had the kings and the pharaohs who ruled over the pagan world, they made images of them where they merged the person, the leader, the king or the queen with the God or goddess that they represented. So that's why when you look at the pictures of the Pharaohs, they have all this stuff around them. Well, that's linked to the God, could there actually be that with Kamala Harris? And just before she entered the White House for the first time, an image appears on the internet and the image was actually put up by her own family. And what it shows is it's the image of Kamala Harris merged with the image of a Hindu goddess. Literally, it's her face and it's a Hindu goddess with many arms on the internet. It's the avatar, it's the merging of a person with a god. And she's riding into war. Now, this is another strange thing about it. She's riding into war and she's fighting a creature where they put the head of Donald Trump on it, and she's riding on a lion that they put the head of buy-in on it. Now, on top of everything, this is 2020.

Michele Bachmann: So this was done by Kamala Harris's team?

Jonathan Cahn: By her niece, yes.

Michele Bachmann: By her niece.

Jonathan Cahn: Yes, yes. And that's right. And the thing is that this was in 2020, but it's showing her as the contender against it on top. She wasn't. It was Joe Biden, who was the presidential candidate, but it's showing her as if she was, and she's riding on top of Biden. So him support, that was in 2024, not 2020. So it was almost like a prophetic image. But here is the ancient image. This is what happened. You look at the engravings of Egypt and you're seeing it on the internet manifest. I mean, how stunning is that? They actually merged her with a Hindu goddess, her own family.

Michele Bachmann: And all of this sounds very complicated, but our beloved friend, Rabbi Jonathan Cahn, a messianic rabbi of his congregation in New Jersey. He's written many, many *New York Times* best-seller books. The newest one, *The Avatar*, that's what we're discussing today, *The Return of the Ancients and the Future of America*. You can buy this book anywhere online. And so you're trying to explain this for us. So if it's complicated, please make sure you buy this book. Buy this for your friends so that they can understand. So could you tell us, Rabbi, what does the sign of the avatar mean for us, for those of us here in America? What does it mean for America?

Jonathan Cahn: Well, it means that we were that close. Here's a nation that the foundation is totally of God. We existed for God's purpose. We existed to fulfill the Puritans committed America, consecrated it to God. And then again, we've been reconsecrated to God and His purposes. But we have been so much, our culture has been so much pushing God out and driving God out that we actually had a person running for the highest leader of the land to rule the land, not only with

an agenda that went against the Bible in life, in gender, in everything, religious freedom. I mean, everything was radical. But also that was named the goddess, a named after a Hindu goddess. So it would be that the leader of America would be called "the goddess." So it's like a sign of where we are when you turn away from God. But the thing is that we were spared for now because it went to another.

Michele Bachmann: That's what's so shocking that America could be founded on such a firm foundation, and yet, as you write in your book, *The Avatar*, in the 2020 and the 2024 race, we see how America was choosing the exact opposite of what America was founded on.

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah.

Michele Bachmann: Would you tell our audience in this show, what is the final mystery that you write about in *The Avatar* of Donald Trump?

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah, it goes even deeper. We talk about Jehu, but actually Jehu, when he was announced king, they sounded the trumpets or the shofar. So there's a mystery. Lemme think about it. His name means... we talk about Kamala Harris's name. Donald Trump's name means Trump. In English, it's the trumpet. Now the thing is that, and I spoke about the day of the birth of Kamala Harris. Is there a mystery or something that manifested on the day of Donald Trump's birth? Well, when he was born, he wasn't born on a pagan holiday. He was born on a biblical holy day. He was born on Friday. Friday, ushers in the Sabbath and every Sabbath. So all around the world, they're reading Scripture. Because every Sabbath, there was an appointed scripture to be read. It's appointed from ages past for that particular day or that particular Sabbath. So what was the Scripture appointed for the Sabbath on which Donald Trump was born? Think about it. The Scripture was God calling into being an instrument, a vessel, literally a trumpet. It's literally about the trumpet. It's like a trumpet's loud. A trumpet is jarring, but a trumpet is, it doesn't have to know what it's doing, but it's used by God. So the mystery is even there from the day of his birth.

Michele Bachmann: And that's the Scripture that's on the calendar of readings in the Jewish world, right?

Jonathan Cahn: Yes. And when I mentioned the Scripture that says, sound, the trump..., when you're in war, sound, the trumpet and the enemy will be defeated. Well, that was also appointed for the day of Donald Trump's birth.

Michele Bachmann: And that means victory.

Jonathan Cahn: That's what that means.

Michele Bachmann: So what does this have to do with the gods?

Jonathan Cahn: Well, remember at the beginning I shared, I sounded, the Bible speaks about the trumpet and warfare, and I'm sounding the trumpet in India, and we see this mass thing with, and then the trumpet in India, it's actually the trumpet on the plate on that image that's struck the head of the idol. So the trumpet actually, it's saying that Trump is not only someone who's used politically, but ultimately it's spiritually. It's against the spirits. You know when He says and declares, there's only male and female on his first day. Yes, that's against the gods. That's against the agenda of Ishtar, which was to merge genders. When He talks about life or He comes against abortion, that's against Malik, that's against bail. So it's literally that. And when you think about that, when you mentioned it, you said, well, what a choice we had. Well, think about this. I mean, if you pull away the veil, and that is that one person who was running for president, his name means the trumpet Trump, and the other one, the one who's running, the name means the goddess. So you have the trumpet and the goddess or the spirit and the trumpet prevailed and the goddess fled.

Michele Bachmann: Well, and that's why I think your book is so interesting, *The Avatar, The Return of the Ancients and the Future of America*, because we see this template in the Scripture, and we just see it repeated throughout history, and I think that's why our audience will find this so interesting. Jonathan Cahn is a beloved messianic leader in America, and he's very well known. He's had over a hundred million views on YouTube. And he writes prophetically, he looks at what the Scripture says, and he unfolds what the Scripture says in our day and time. We're grateful for the ministry that you have. And so in your book, you also reveal the mystery of an ancient priesthood that laid behind the assassination attempt on Donald Trump's life. That was in, it was July 13th. I'll never forget it. July 13th, 2024, Butler, Pennsylvania. So talk about this ancient priesthood that laid behind the assassination attempt.

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah. Now, Jehu was the only king of the northern kingdom where the Bible actually records that he was anointed. And now the first anointing in the Bible is the most massive, detailed, is the anointing of the priesthood. If you're going to serve God, you're got to be anointed. And so they would anoint the priest to serve the purposes of God. In the priestly anointing, they weren't just anointed by oil, they were anointed by blood, and the blood had to touch the ear of the one being called to the office.

Michele Bachmann: That's in the Bible. That's written in the Bible.

Jonathan Cahn: It is. And it wasn't only miraculous that Donald Trump, that was a miracle, but it also, it touched his ear. It had to touch the right ear. It touches his right ear, had to touch the tip of the right ear, touches the tip of Trump's right ear. Then the blood has to touch the hand. And so the first thing that Trump does is he brings his hand up to touch the blood, and it has to touch the right hand. It's his right hand. It has to touch the thumb. The right thumb it touches. The right thumb goes up to his ear. The next thing is the feet. Now the feet, we can't say what happened. We'd have pictures of it. But in order for the blood to touch the feet, his shoes had to be removed. Trump is then pushed down to the place where

the blood had gone down, and literally his shoes are removed. He says, "I need my shoes."

Michele Bachmann: I remember that. I remember the Secret Service were trying to get him off the stage, and he said, "I need my shoes." So obviously his shoes were off.

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah. What's that about? And the thing, but in the priestly anointing, the shoes have to be removed. And some of the commentaries, Michele, we will talk about the priest as being the candidate for the priesthood, and then they go into the office of the priesthood. So here you have the candidate. Now the thing is, the whole thing takes seven days. The seventh day is when the priest gets really invested with the office. Well, if you take, when this happened, this was as you said, it was that Saturday, and it happened in the date. Now the Hebrew day begins at sundown. So the first day is when it happened. Then sundown comes sundown to sundown. That's the second day. So keep counting. When do you get to, what's the seventh day? When you get to the seventh day? Anything happened? The seventh day is the day that Donald Trump received the nomination to become President of the United States. The seventh day into the office. I mean, from the moment this happened, Michele, it was sealed.

Michele Bachmann: That's right. It was right after.

Jonathan Cahn: Yep. No accident.

Michele Bachmann: Yeah. And I think what you have shown us again is that God is so loving. He is so good to the United States, that He is giving us hope and an opportunity to reject these false gods that have come into the United States. How weird is this? In about five minutes, it seems like America said, you're a bigot if you don't believe that little boys can become girls. But what you've given us here is not just the problem. You've given us a solution. And so just state one more time for our audience, the solution that you state so well in your new book for America, that we're not without hope. We have hope. And let our listeners know what that hope is.

Jonathan Cahn: Yeah. There is only one hope, and the problem isn't cultural and economic and political. The problem is ultimately spiritual. When we turn away from God, the only way is to return to God. And the thing is that, that God is always a God of hope. Literally, He has given us a window. And so the thing is, we can't just pray for revival. We have to do that as never before. But we have to actually choose to live in revival because if we start living in revival, then revival begins. And so that is the hope. God is the God of hope. And listen, this is the most exciting. I don't know about you, Michele, I'm sure you feel the same way. This is the most exciting hour. This is what we're born for. This is what we are called for. Don't be afraid of it, because God chose you to be in this time. He chose us to be here. So let's go full out for God. Our God is on the throne.

Michele Bachmann: Amen. It's written in the Bible that the prophets who wrote the early Scriptures, they long to live in this moment of history. That's why this book, *The Avatar* is so important. I want to thank you Rabbi Jonathan Cahn, for being on Dr. Dobson's Family Talk show today. And we're so grateful that you could speak to this audience that we are not without a hope. We have a hope if we look to the Scripture, because what does discipleship means? It means read the Word and obey it. And we may read it, but if we don't obey it, then we are no better off than any other individual. This is the moment to lift up and revere the Scriptures. Every word is God breathed. Every word is true. And it's our time to obey those words. And you have given us this moment. You've tied it together, and we can't thank you enough. So thank you, Rabbi Cahn.

Jonathan Cahn: Oh, thank you, Michele. It's always a joy. Thank you.

Michele Bachmann: And again, how can our audience get a copy of this book for themselves?

Jonathan Cahn: Literally, *The Avatar* is everywhere, but if you go online right now, you'll see it. If you go on Amazon or any place you get books, you'll see *The Avatar*. Make sure it's not the movie. It says *The Avatar: The Return of the Ancients and the Future of America*. And think of people in your life who need to be saved or need to know or be awakened. Even if they are saved, get it for them too. This is the hour.

Michele Bachmann: Amen. God bless you and God bless all of you in this audience. Amen.

Rabbi Jonathan Cahn: Amen.
