## Applications

Complete the application form and screening questions, and attach your CV and transcripts. If studying law as a postgraduate or double degree, include transcripts for your other degree(s).

Enter your law degree WAM only, not your combined WAM.

If semester results are released after applications close, note this in your application and email your updated transcript to [gtcareers@gtlaw.com.au](mailto:gtcareers@gtlaw.com.au) once received.

All candidates will be notified of the outcome by email no later than 17 July.

## Online testing

If your application progresses to the next stage, you'll receive an email to complete SHL's Global Skills Assessment. The deadline for completing this assessment is Wednesday 15 July 2026, 11.59pm.

## Super Saturday Assessment Centre

After successfully completing testing, candidates will be invited to an assessment centre on Saturday 8 August 2026.

The assessment centre includes an interview with a partner and a lawyer, an individual exercise and a group activity. You can also network with lawyers, graduates and former summer clerks.
