Dear Valued Customer,

Following the communication of our decision to obsolete the Revolution pump range on August 25, 2026, we are instigating a Last Time Buy (LTB) period to enable you to help end users plan appropriately for their individual requirements.

Following initial feedback from our Distribution Partners we have decided to extend the initial LTB period for Revolution pumps beyond September 30th to October 31st, 2026.

From this date onward, we will no longer accept orders for replacement pumps or non-wear spare parts.

After 31 October 2026, our support plan includes:

- Warranty: Standard warranty T & Cs apply
- Availability of wear spare parts for 5 year period (please [click here](#) to see PDF list for full detail)

- Optional last time buy opportunity for customers wishing to secure long term inventory. All last time buy orders will be reviewed, with lead times confirmed at order confirmation stage.

We remain committed to supporting our customers and distributors during this LTB process and will continue to provide:

- Technical support and assistance from our engineering team
- Support with spare parts planning and lifecycle management
- Assistance in evaluating transition options to alternative pump models where appropriate
