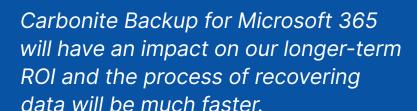

Carbonite complements Microsoft data recovery and backup

Enhanced, an MSP in the UK, supports 350 clients, in a range of industries from manufacturing to logistics to accounting, that rely heavily on Microsoft 365. James Cripps heads up the infrastructure division for the company and is responsible for backup, security, networking, connectivity, and other services. Enhanced uses SolarWinds RMM to roll out services to clients, 75% of which are fully managed.

To remain competitive in the marketplace, Enhanced secures clients by providing industry leading technology, but, ultimately, customer experience is their differentiator. Enhanced provides data retention and backup guidance to clients with and without in-house IT teams.

Problem – Before Carbonite[®] Backup for Microsoft 365

In recent years, the Enhanced team has worked hard to improve their clients' security. They implemented robust security and networking tools and policies to prevent malware and ransomware infections. In part due to these efforts, data loss and the need for recovery after ransomware attacks had become more and more rare, but data loss from user error continued to be widespread.

Over time, more and more clients began relying on the flexibility of the cloud. Clients had moved data to the cloud using products like Microsoft 365 and Microsoft Azure. In shifting to the cloud, Enhanced staff saw opportunities to help clients better understand cloud storage, data protection and backup. While data protection and backup are included in many Microsoft tools, Enhanced found that third-party providers often offer better protection than the built-in capabilities of business productivity tools, such as Teams and Sharepoint.

"There's quite a lot of misunderstanding in the industry around recovery around on Microsoft 365 and what kind of protection that entails. Yes, you can recover with those built-in tools, but there are a few scenarios where they don't cover you. Clients have begun to realize the importance of some of their data, and the big picture of all their data," explained Cripps.

After experiencing a few lengthy data restores with Microsoft after customers had started using Microsoft 365, they began to search for a tool to complement the built-in data recovery and backup of Microsoft cloud products.

"Recovering data from Microsoft is not quick. Retention policies don't provide protection for every recovery scenario you might face. In most cases, we have gotten data back from Microsoft, but often our clients are looking for a single email and would rather do a granular restore instead of restoring an entire mailbox. This tool helps our clients who are looking for specific restores," said Cripps.

Enhanced sees their clients as the most critical element in securing business data. Accidental deletions are quite common and even, occasionally, disgruntled inside actors taking advantage of their network access. However, it happens—sometimes when an asset is simply thought to be insignificant until it's needed—unintentional deletions are regular occurrences.

After Carbonite – A Third-Party Backup and Recovery Solution

"I did a review of products and chose Carbonite Backup for Microsoft 365 because we had already trusted Carbonite for several years.
