Steps to prompting

- 1. What is my objective?
- 2. What is the best tool for the job?
- 3. Write version 1
 - a. Use specific references
 - b. Type like you'd speak
- 4. How can I learn from that error?
- 5. Repeat



How to know which tool to use?

Analyze Data

- Surface new insights
- Digest qualitative data (sentiment, etc.)
- Summarize what my sheet is doing
- Create ad hoc charts
- Point-in-time result is acceptable

Generate Formula

- Outcome entirely accessible in cell data
- Needs to scale beyond ten rows
- Needs to be dynamic

Text & Summaries

- Needs intelligence beyond sheet data
- Produce novel content inspired by sheet data
- Produce unique output row (up to 10 at a time)
- Point-in-time result is acceptable

Get Help

- The Smartsheet guru of your dreams
- General Smartsheet knowledge, not your stuff
