

What is Sedation-Free TNE?

Sedation-free transnasal endoscopy (TNE), a form of flexible endoscopy that does not require general anesthesia, has been reported in adult and pediatric medical publications for over 20 years.


TNE in pediatric gastroenterology was developed by an aerodigestive medicine team, which is a collaboration with pulmonology, and otolaryngology. This procedure improves quality, efficiency, and safety for children undergoing upper GI endoscopy.



No general anesthesia or sedation required



No IVs or needles required



TNE as a procedure allows for the evaluation of upper gastrointestinal tract disease and includes:

TN-Eso Transnasal Esophagoscopy

TN-EG Transnasal Gastroesophagoscopy

TN-EGD Transnasal Esophagogastroduodenoscopy
