Make an Impact with Youth Large Print

Project Tomorrow conducted a nationwide study to measure the efficacy of large print in classroom reading. Teachers noted distractions as the top student reading challenge, but large print positively impacted reader engagement and more.

Benefits on Reading Skills & Focus

Teachers saw **notable improvements** when below-grade-level readers read large print.

noted better letter and word recognition

84% reported better retention

84% said readers read for longer without distraction

Influence on Student Mindsets About Reading

Over half of teachers observed decreased reading anxiety for students across reading levels.




See the Large Print Difference With a larger font size, expanded line spacing, and fewer words per page, large print helps students turn pages
