

- Amateur Newspapers from the American Antiquarian Society**  
Amateur Newspapers from the American Antiquarian Society were a genre of nineteenth-century newspapers, written and published mainly by juvenile enthusiasts for the goal of publishing, not profiting. Some papers focused on general news, while others offered editorials, original literature, puzzles, or other matters of personal interest. In many ways, amateur newspapers can be thought of as the social media of their time, offering young adults a way to express their views and opinions.
- American Fiction, 1774-1920**  
*American Fiction, 1774-1920*, demonstrates the utility of having more than 18,000 works of fiction in one place, in a consistent format. Titles up until 1900 are sourced from Lyle H. Wright's *American Fiction: A Contribution Towards a Bibliography*. Titles after 1900 are sourced from the Library of Congress Shelf List of American Adult Fiction and the Geoffrey D. Smith bibliography.
- American Historical Periodicals from the American Antiquarian Society**  
*American Historical Periodicals from the American Antiquarian Society* offers a documentary history of the Colonial Americans in the twentieth century, presenting North American thought, culture, and society through a variety of perspectives. Focused on American concerns, they were predominantly published in the U.S., Canada, and by Americans living abroad. From long-running publications to ephemeral titles, each periodical offers a cross-section of the developing United States.
- Archives of Sexuality and Gender**  
The Archives of Sexuality and Gender program provides a robust and significant collection of primary sources for the historical study of sex, sexuality, and gender. Description: Frank Leslie produced one of the most successful news magazines of the second half of the 19th century. Launched in December 1855, Leslie's Illustrated Newspaper was unique in commissioning newsworthy instead of merely generic engravings. During the Civil War many artists and engravers began famous careers working for Leslie or the rival Harper's Weekly. Artist and engraver Thomas Nast, for example, worked for both. In 1894 the title changed to Leslie's Illustrated Weekly.





#### Proximity

Use Proximity Operators to Define Distance Between Terms

Proximity operators (**Nn**, **Wn**) can be used to tell the search engine how closely terms must be to each other within a document. They operate like the AND operator in that both terms must be found.

Use **Nn** to find terms when order doesn't matter

The Nn (near) operator finds terms n words apart in either direction of the first term.

- memory n5 repressed** finds documents that contain *memory* and *repressed* within five or fewer words of each other.

Use **Wn** to find terms after the first

The Wn (within) operator finds the second term within n words after the first.

- shared w3 values** finds documents that contain the term *values* within three or fewer words after the term *shared*.







## Lawyers who will not let George Washington lie

NEW YORK

A TEAM of British lawyers meets tomorrow to plan its case for the prosecution of the first President of the United States for treason.

George Washington, the founding father of the United States was a traitor, Lord Goff of Chieveley, told America's leading lawyers in Washington last week.

Backed by Mr Allan Green, QC, the Director of Public Prosecutions, the Law Lord challenged his transatlantic colleagues to defend George Washington from charges of treason, sedition, high crimes and misdemeanours.

With the pride of the nation at stake, and coming just before Independence Day, the American Inns of the Court had to accept.

A trial has been set for October 18 in London's Lincoln's Inn and a Law Lord is being asked to act as the judge.

The case will be set in 1776, the fiction being that George Washington had been captured and brought to London to face trial.

Witnesses for the defence are likely to be Americans and Britons taking the roles of Edmund Burke, Thomas Paine and Benjamin Franklin.

Those for the prosecution will probably include the Prime Minister of the time, Lord North, as well as King George III.

Mr Goffield already has the planks of the defence mapped out. The first will be that loyalty to the crown involves a two-way responsibility and that George III failed to keep his side of the bargain by not offering the people in the American colonies the same rights enjoyed by his subjects in England.

"It takes two to dance and we were not allowed on the dance floor," says Mr Goffield.

The second main argument for the defence will be a charge that George III was happy to let go of the troublesome colony and put up only token resistance to the revolutionary forces led by Washington.

Mr Coffield said: "History shows that George III did not send his best or his brightest officers. It is no wonder we beat them because the whole thing was a set-up."

Objection, cries George Washington's lead counsel, Mr Michael Coffield, who heads a 90-strong practice in Chicago.

Mr Coffield admits that America's first president would have gone the same way if he had fallen into enemy hands during the war, but adds: "That does not mean it would have been a just verdict."

Plans to have a jury made up of British lawyers does not sit comfortably with Mr Coffield. Neither does the fact that a British judge will preside.

Mr Berkin has assured his American rivals that the jury will be filled by "honourable people who will try the case on its merits and without bias".

But Mr Coffield is not convinced: "If it were a question of law, we would undoubtedly win. But the odds are being stacked up against us.

"We are not happy about having 12 good men and true all from the London area. We are suggesting we do not have a jury and that a panel is chosen on which one of our justices would sit to give a little balance."

A dispute has also arisen over the American suggestion that actors are used to play the witnesses.


"A terrible idea," Mr Berkin says. "What we need are people who can act a little but are lawyers or historians and will not buckle under cross-examination."

The precedents, however, do not look too good for the American team.


