

# 2026 ASCO MedOnc In-Training Exam (ITE) Registration FAQs

## Exam Details and Logistics

Question	Answer
What are the 2026 exam dates?	The <b>primary exam dates</b> are <b>February 24-25, 2026</b> . A make-up exam is scheduled for March 5, 2026.
What is the exam format?	The ITE is a <b>6-hour, 200-question</b> exam. It is a case-based, multiple-choice exam that is administered over two days at the site's local time (starting at <b>9:00 AM</b> ). However, to adjust start time, contact <a href="mailto:ITE@asco.org">ITE@asco.org</a> .
However, Is the exam pass/fail?	No. The ITE is a <b>low-stakes exam</b> intended for <b>self-evaluation</b> and program improvement. It is a teaching tool, and participants are advised not to study.
What are the proctoring options?	The exam must be taken in a formal, proctored environment. Programs can opt for <b>in-person</b> or <b>virtual proctoring</b> (via WebEx, Zoom, or Microsoft Teams).
What is the cost for the 2026 ITE?	<b>\$295 per trainee for ASCO members, \$400 for non-members, and \$55 for faculty</b> . Discounted rates are available for World Bank-designated low- and middle-income countries.
How does scoring work?	Score reports, which will be distributed to <b>Program Directors</b> , provide teaching points for missed questions and percentages of questions answered correctly by subject area. Answer choices are <b>not</b> included.

## Preparation and Trainee Requirements

Question	Answer
Why must trainees update their Date of Birth (DOB)?	<b>DOB is mandatory</b> for system registration. If a trainee's DOB is missing, you will be unable to finalize their exam registration. Information can be updated at <a href="https://profile.asco.org">https://profile.asco.org</a>
Is ASCO membership required?	No, but it is strongly encouraged. Members receive a <b>discounted exam rate</b> . Trainees can apply for <b>free membership</b> at <a href="https://join.asco.org">https://join.asco.org</a>
What if a contact or examinee doesn't show up in the registration search?	If you cannot locate an examinee when searching in the registration site, then they do not have an active ASCO account linked to that email. They must create an account first or update their contact information by visiting <a href="https://account.asco.org">https://account.asco.org</a>

## Registration and Invoicing

Question	Answer
<b>Why is the Training Year so important?</b>	Selecting the <b>correct Training Year is MANDATORY</b> as it determines accurate exam data tracking and score reporting.  Faculty taking the exam must select <b>None/Program Director/Faculty</b> . To receive the correct exam rate.
<b>Can I register someone who took last year's exam?</b>	In the 2026 ASCO ITE Registration Guide, go to the <b>Previous Year Exam Registration</b> tab and click <b>Add Examinee</b> next to the individual's name.
<b>What is the deadline for making changes?</b>	<b>Sunday, February 1, 2026</b>  <b>Please ensure you make any changes (updates or deletions before the date).</b>
<b>When will we be invoiced?</b>	Your program will be invoiced based on the final list of examinees recorded in the system on Sunday, <b>February 1, 2026</b> , and invoices will be distributed by end of February. Payment will be due in April 2026.
