Initiatives Supported by your Latin America Regional Council:

- ▶ **International Clinical Research Scholars Program (ICRS):** ICRS aims to guide participants through the process of refining a research question, developing a protocol, leading a research team, statistical considerations, data collection and interpretation, and writing a manuscript. This program equips participants in Latin America with skills to lead research teams and submit their data for publication.
- ▶ **ASCO Latin America Leadership Development Program (LDP-LATAM):** Develops skills in leadership, communication, presentation, and conflict management, empowering participants to assume leadership roles within the region and ASCO. Find more information at asco.org/leadership.
- ▶ **International Cancer Corps (ICC):** The ICC's mission is to improve the quality of cancer care at medical institutions in low- and middle-income countries by providing education and training to clinical staff. The Latin America Regional Council selected Instituto Oncológico del Oriente Boliviano in Santa Cruz, Bolivia.
- ▶ **JCO® Global Oncology (GO) Special Series:** JCO GO is developing a special series on cancer care in Latin America, highlighting both challenges and advances in the region. The series will release in 2025.
