INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Visit <https://demos.gurobi.com/gurobean-game/> and click on "championship mode".
2. Create a unique "match code" that is less than 20 characters long. You can use a mix of letters and numbers for this match code*.
NOTE: match codes are case-sensitive, and you don't need to register your code before the competition. You just need to distribute the selected code and check to see that it isn't already in use by testing a data download with your match code (see #7 below).
3. Distribute the assigned alphanumeric match code to your class and ask them to select "championship mode" from the game's homepage when they are starting game play.
4. Run your Championship game; be sure to visit the game's landing page at www.gurobean.com to access the supplementary teaching resources (such as a sample lesson plan, teaching guides, and a template slide deck for teaching the game)
5. Ask students to be sure to save their scores at the end of the game.
6. As the instructor, you will need to start a game using the match code that you created.
7. Within the championship game, you can click on the trophy icon within the in-game bulletin board (see image to the right) to download the scores (with student aliases, timestamps, and scores) to view the class/ session results.
