Preparing to Launch

Born into a community that did not value girls and to parents consumed trying to make enough money for food, no one noticed as Editor Adhiambo Ochieng and her two sisters suffered from gender based violence as young girls. Although she flourished in secondary school, Editor became pregnant at age 18 as a result of continuous abuse, forcing her to skip college and shaming her into leaving home.

Editor's life changed course, however, when she found SHOFCO. Kennedy offered his shared experience of struggle and an opportunity to join SHOFCO's youth group. Inspired, Editor trained to become the Youth Peer Provider Coordinator, where she now leads SHOFCO youth in sexual health and GBV outreach efforts in Kibera. Editor's dream is to create a healthier, educated community, where GBV isn't the norm, perpetrators are prosecuted, and there is an open atmosphere for survivors to share their stories. "I believe that when you break the silence, we end the violence," she says. SHOFCO has been busy helping thousands like Editor create positive change in their lives, and these stories of success

are spreading. Neighboring communities have asked for our innovative model and we have responded. In 2013, working with local community leaders we secured land in the slum of Mathare for our planned second school for girls and worked with the local community to develop SHOFCO's model in this new community.

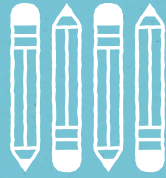

We also understand that scaling a model means implementing best practices from experience. That's why in 2013 we worked hard to deepen

our programming in Kibera. At our flagship Kibera School for Girls we grew to 142 students; we launched a maternal and child healthcare wing at our clinic, strengthening our services in this specialty and enabling us to treat nearly 200 patients each day; by adding a third distribution kiosk we increased our clean water capacity, selling nearly 1 million gallons in 2013.

At SHOFCO, we grow through grassroots leadership. SHOFCO staff will be as prepared to make visions of Editor's dreams come true tomorrow in Mathare as they are in Kibera today. We continue to be more than a school—we are a movement.

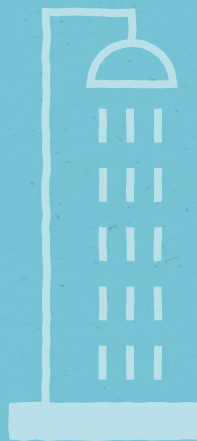

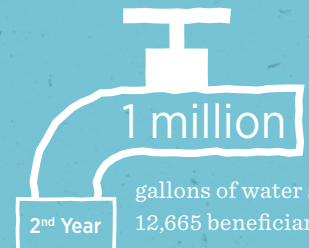

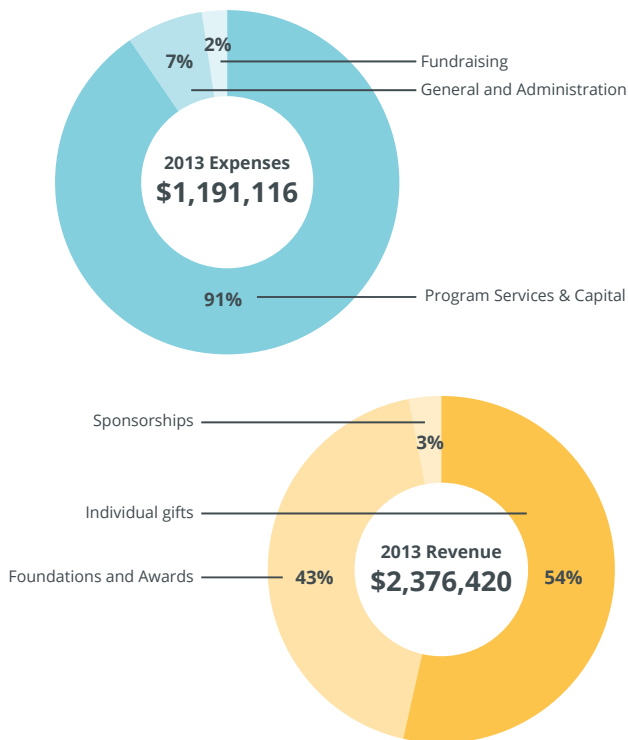
