



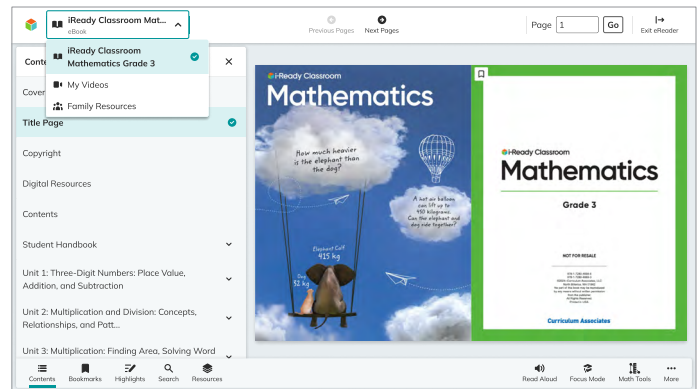
# Digital Student Bookshelf

Displayed as “Bookshelf” on the student dashboard, the Digital Student Bookshelf is the online version of the *i-Ready Classroom Mathematics* student materials. It allows students to highlight, take notes, or have the pages of the Student Worktext read to them.

Use the Digital Student Bookshelf to differentiate for students who benefit from audio support, as a homework resource, and to encourage family engagement in student learning of mathematics content.

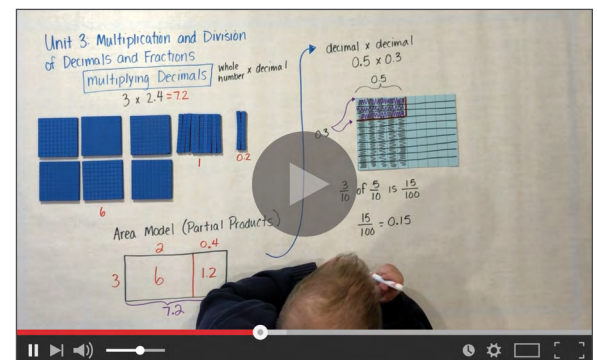
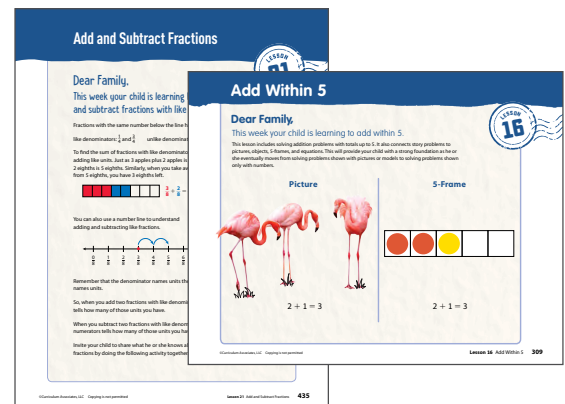
**Using the left navigation, students are able to access the Front and Back of their Student Worktext containing many resources in addition to their lesson pages, such as . . .**

- Mathematical Practices
- Mathematical Language Reference Tool
- 100 Mathematical Discourse Questions
- Bilingual English/Spanish Glossary and Multilingual Glossary
- STEM stories
- Cumulative Practice
- Academic Vocabulary Glossary
- And more!



**Many Family Resources exist as well—encourage families to access . . .**

- The **Family Center** for answers to frequently asked questions helping families understand the program and how they can support their students. This includes information about the Diagnostic for Mathematics.
- The **Family Letters** that are available for every lesson and include an overview of the mathematics, a vocabulary review, and an activity related to the lesson. (Available in multiple languages.)
- **Unit Flow and Progression Videos** available for each unit that show the progression of concepts within the *i-Ready Classroom Mathematics* unit to help families understand the standards and strategies taught. (Closed-captioned in English and Spanish.)





## My Progress


My Progress allows students to track their own progress and take ownership of their learning. They will be able to see—and share with their families—what they have accomplished in *i-Ready Classroom Mathematics* digital assignments.

1. Students have the option to **Show All** completed assignments or, if using Personalized Instruction, to filter by lessons and domain.
2. Students can view **Completed Work**, including all completed Teacher-Assigned and My Path items. They will receive their scores for complete Diagnostics, Comprehension Checks, and Lesson Quizzes (if applicable). They will also see that Interactive Practice assignments have been completed.
