i-Ready Diagnostic National Norms: Grades 9–10

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Research Overview

This publication features the *i-Ready Diagnostic* national norms for Grades 9–10 for the fall. These norms are based on data from the 2022–2023 school year and apply to the 2024–2025 school year. These norms are new for the 2024-2025 school year and replace those norms that were in place between the 2020–2021 and 2023-2024 school year. As is common for national norms, it is expected that these norms will remain in use for a number of school years, although Curriculum Associates will continue to monitor the norms each year to determine when new norms are needed.

What are i-Ready Diagnostic norms?

Norms within *i-Ready* provide a way for educators to compare how their students are performing relative to other students across the country.

How do you interpret i-Ready Diagnostic national norms?

Norms are percentiles, comparing each student's performance with a set of nationally representative samples of students in the same grade level who took the Diagnostic at the same time of year. For example, a student whose fall Diagnostic norm is 90 scored better than 90% of a nationally representative group of students who took the Diagnostic in the fall.

Normative scores, together with other types of scores such as *i-Ready Diagnostic* criterion-referenced scores (i.e., grade-level placements for reading and mathematics and for domains) help educators gain a more complete picture of student performance. Whereas *i-Ready*'s normative scores communicate how students perform compared to other students, criterion-referenced scores communicate what students know and can do against grade-level standards.

National norms corresponding to overall scale scores are available for both the *i-Ready Diagnostics* for Reading and Mathematics.

Where are the national norms located in i-Ready?

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* normative scores are labeled as "percentile ranks" in *i-Ready* and are located in various places on the *i-Ready* platform, such as the Diagnostic Results (Class) report and the Diagnostic Results (Student) report. Percentile ranks are also available in the Diagnostic Results export.

Currently *i-Ready Diagnostic* only has national norms in high school for Grades 9–10 in the fall. For other high school grades and testing windows, the "percentile ranks" will appear blank. Curriculum Associates has an ongoing research effort underway to eventually release national norms for other high school testing windows and grades.



What dates are used for i-Ready's norming windows?

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* assessment has three norming windows: fall, winter, and spring. The normative percentile rank associated with a given *i-Ready Diagnostic* scale score will differ across normative testing windows.

How often are i-Ready Diagnostic norms updated?

Consistent with well-established practices in educational assessment, the *i-Ready* national norms are evaluated every year to determine if an update is needed. The newest norms are based on data from the 2022–2023 school year and are for use beginning with the 2024–2025 school year. Previously, the newest norms were those that were in place between the 2020–2021 school year and the 2023–2024 school year, which were based on student data from the 2018–2019 school year. The update prior to those norms was in 2015–2016.

When will i-Ready Diagnostic norms be updated again?

Curriculum Associates evaluates norms every year to determine if new norms are needed and will update the norms when necessary to ensure *i-Ready Diagnostic* norms continue to reflect student performance across the nation.

How can I obtain the data tables in a spreadsheet format?

The norms crosswalks are available in the Diagnostic Data Tables spreadsheet.

How can I get information on the previous norms?

The previous norms were applicable to the 2020–2021 through the 2023–2024 school year. Norms tables for <u>Grades K–8</u> and for <u>Grades 9–10</u> are available.

Technical Note: The Relationship between the Percentile Ranks in i-Ready Reports and Percentile Ranks in this Document

The original norming analysis conducted by Curriculum Associates resulted in tables that provide the percentile rank associated with each *i-Ready Diagnostic* scale score. When translating these results into tables that provide the *i-Ready Diagnostic* scale score associated with each percentile rank the following rules were applied.

- Where multiple i-Ready Diagnostic scale scores exist for a single percentile, the range of scale scores is reported.
- Where a percentile exists with no corresponding Diagnostic score, the Diagnostic score from the next percentile up that does have a score is reported.
