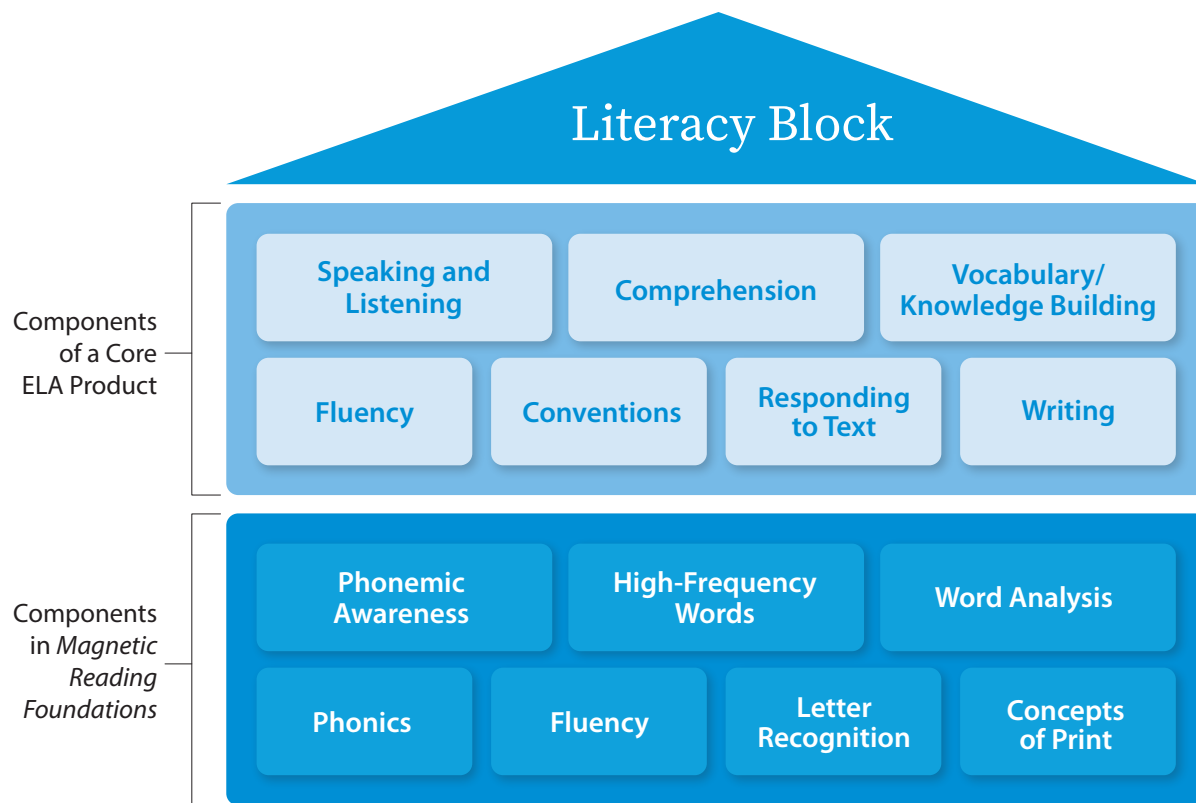


Complement or Complete Your Core Literacy Program

Make Connections to Accelerate Learning

Core basal programs commonly lack the explicit and systematic foundational skills instruction that are a priority for Grades K–2 students. **Using *Magnetic Reading Foundations*' scope and sequence and the following strategies, K–2 teachers can integrate foundational skills practice with a core literacy program to enhance and accelerate learning.**

Topics

- Connect the core program and *Magnetic Reading Foundations* topically to build knowledge
- Reinforce knowledge building and vocabulary building with Magnetic Readers

Writing

- Make connections between writing instruction and letter formation

Fluency
