This year, your student will be using Fluency Flight, a new mathematics fact fluency program by the makers of *i-Ready*. By using Fluency Flight, your student will build mathematics fact fluency with activities that are personalized to the facts they're learning.

Accuracy, automaticity, and understanding of the core mathematics facts in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division are critical for your student's math development. With Fluency Flight's innovative approach, your student will move through the four stages of fluency development as they build understanding of unique sets of mathematics facts before working on accuracy and automaticity. Once students have become automatic with a set of facts, they will be introduced to new facts, while continuing to have opportunities to practice the facts they've already mastered.

Here's how your student can use Fluency Flight:

1. Log in to their *i-Ready* account.
2. Click on the blue Fluency Flight dragon button on the bottom right of their dashboard.





3. Complete the first activity, which starts automatically.
4. Complete a second activity of their choosing.

When your student completes both Fluency Flight activities, the dragon will light up in green.



Students should complete Fluency Flight activities **four days each week**, which should take about eight to 10 minutes each day.
