<ul> <li>Independent Practice ~10 minutes</li> </ul>
Ensure my reading fluency instruction addresses accuracy, rate, expression/prosody, and comprehension
Plan fluency instruction that includes:
<ul> <li>Explicit Instruction. State the objective and model or demonstrate examples and nonexamples.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Guided Practice with Teacher. Use a variety of strategies based on grade-level expectations.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Independent Practice. Include Guided Repeated Oral Reading with Feedback or Scaffolded Silent Sustained Reading.</li> </ul>
Regularly assess students' performance and progress in reading fluency
