

1. Cut along the dashed line.
2. Fold along the solid line.

Articulation Vowel /ōō/ (oo, ew)

To make the sound /ōō/:

- First, bring your lips together like you are blowing out a candle.
- Next, lift the back of your tongue to touch the inside of your upper teeth.
- Then, turn on your voice and push the air out the front of your mouth.
- Place your fingers on your throat and say the sound again. Do you feel your throat vibrate? (Yes.)
