Administering the Diagnostic

Getting Students Ready for the Diagnostic Presentation: English | Spanish

- Plan for testing window:
 - Grades K–1: Allow for two to three 20- to 30-minute testing sessions.
 - Grades 2–6: Allow for two 40- to 50-minute testing sessions.
- Provide headphones.
- Actively proctor:
 - If students are rushing, remind them to take their time and try their best. Give breaks when needed.
 - If students seem stuck or are taking a long time for each item, encourage them to do their best and move on.
