Grade 5

We recommend that teachers use *Magnetic Reading* lessons listed alongside each textbook unit to reinforce the standards in parentheses. *Magnetic Reading* lessons may be taught at the teacher's discretion during the corresponding textbook unit to preteach, reinforce, or reteach standards.

Our editors have chosen the places of best fit for each *Magnetic Reading* lesson, taking into consideration the skill focus of a textbook lesson and the opportunities by its reading passages for students to practice application of a given standard. As a result of this approach, in some cases, the recommended Magnetic Reading lesson may not directly map to the publisher's correlations.
