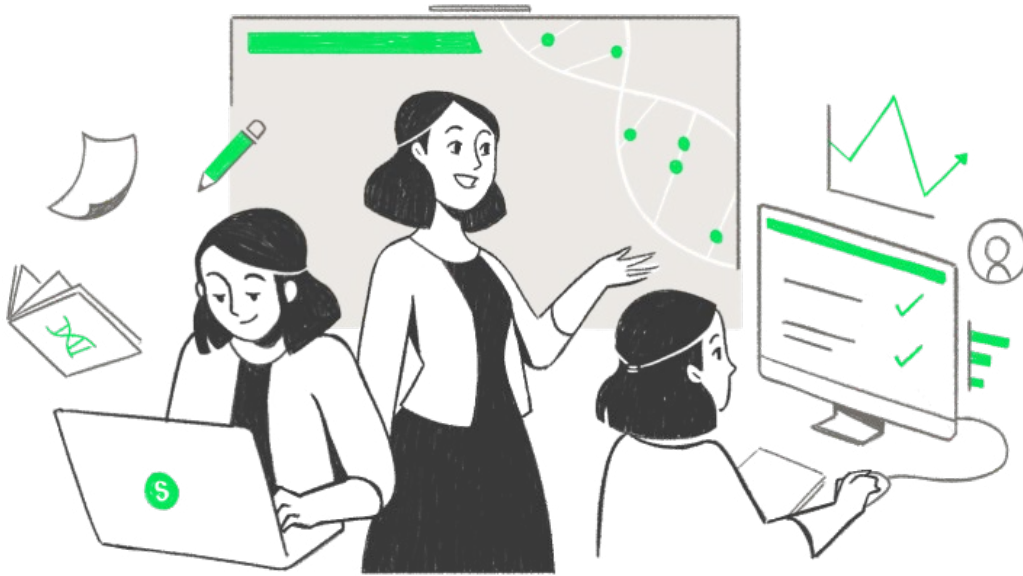

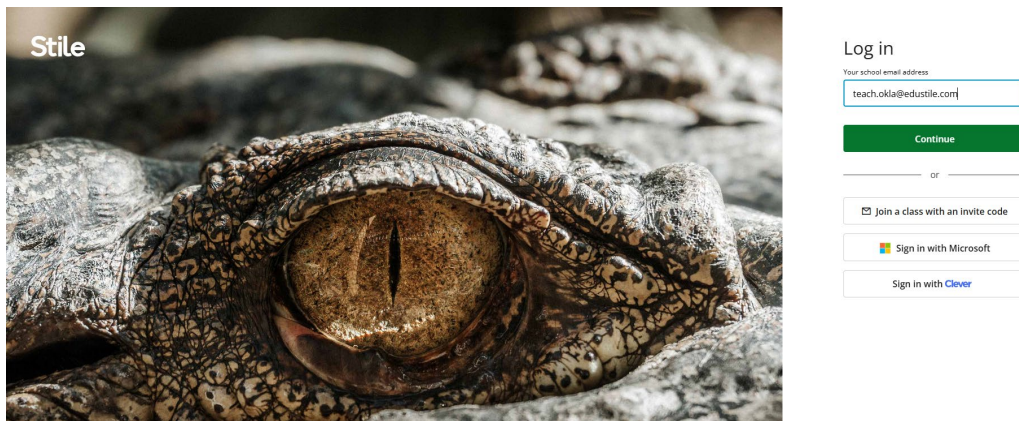

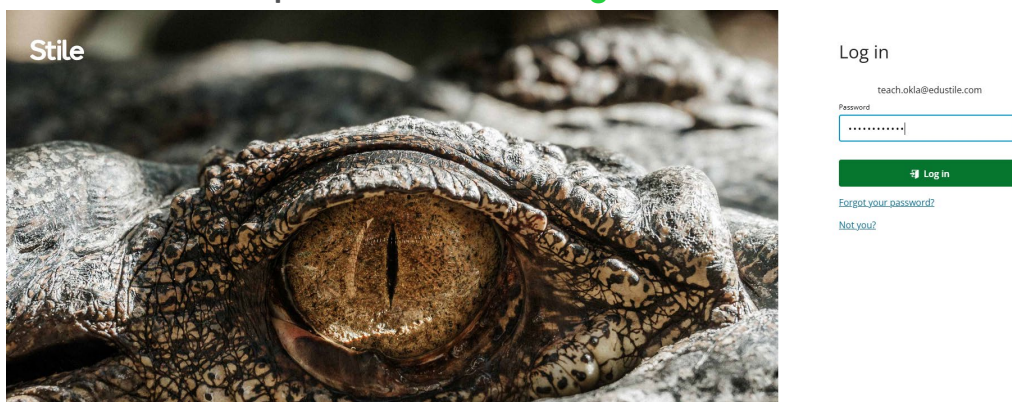
How to login

- 1 Navigate to <https://stileapp.com/login> in your web browser. Enter your username (see “Usernames and passwords”) in the school email address box and click **Continue**.



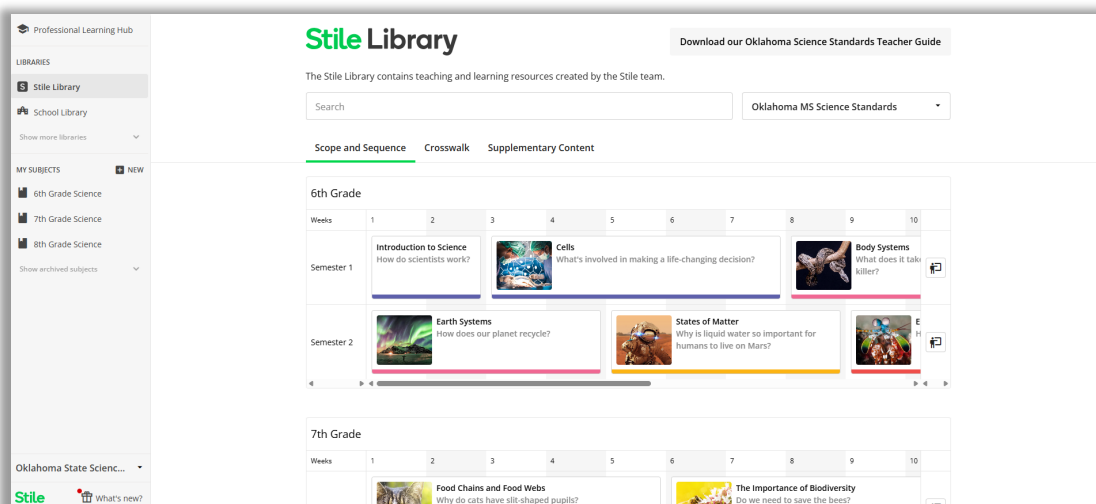

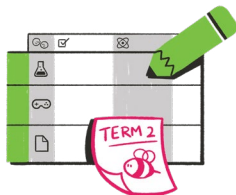

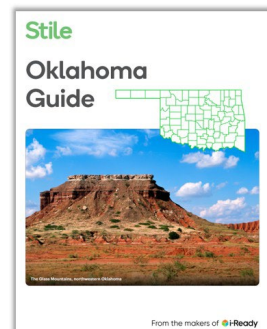

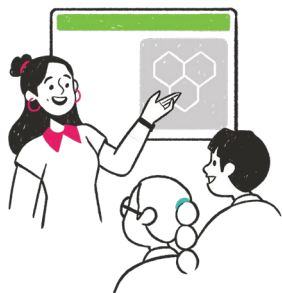

Stile units

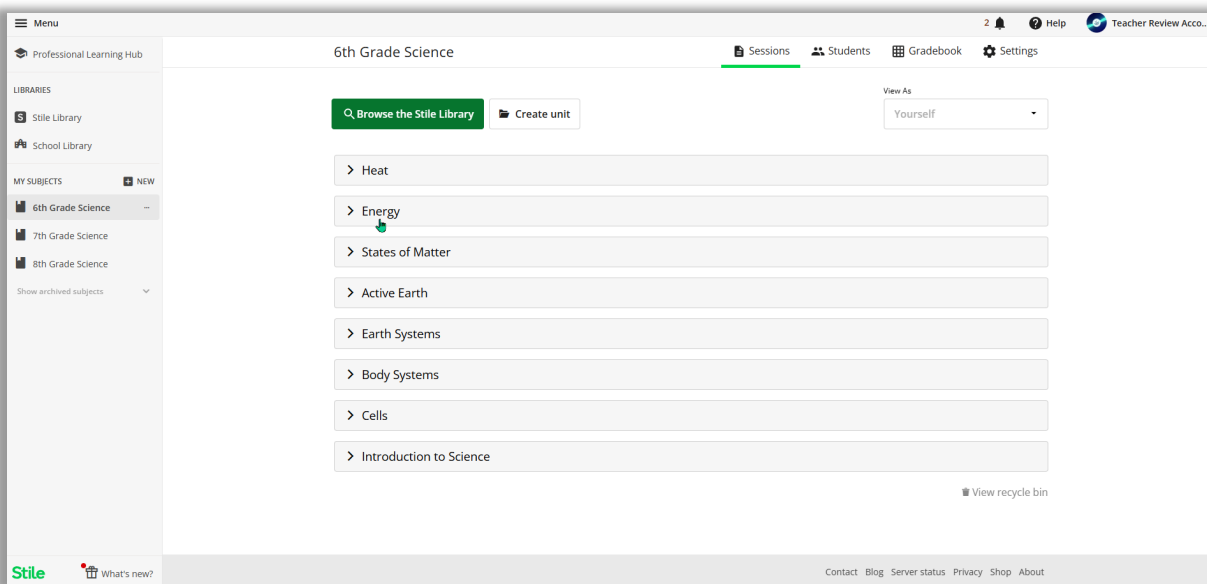


Access by logging into stileapp.com and viewing the units in your 6th, 7th, and 8th grade subjects found on the left hand menu bar.

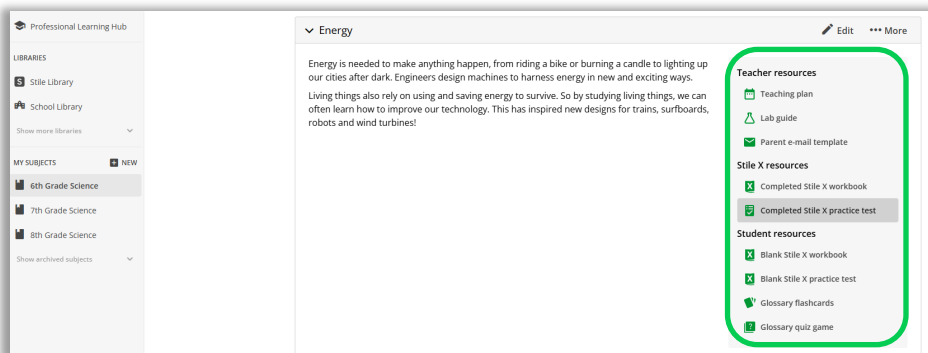
You can view the units either as a teacher or student, depending on the username and password used.
