

Articulation Consonant Digraph /ch/ (*ch, tch*)

To make the sound /ch/:

- Push your lips out slightly to make a circle.
- Place your tongue firmly on the gums behind the front teeth and place your teeth together.
- Let the air build up in your mouth.
- Then push the air out of your mouth quickly to make the sound.
- Place your fingers on your throat and say the sound again.
Do you feel your throat vibrate? (No.)
