


Portland, OR Sees Historic Math Growth

How Portland Public Schools (PPS) Outpaced National Trends

- 1. They developed a **unified vision** of what high-quality teaching and learning should look like every day for every student in every classroom.
- 2. PPS adopted *i-Ready Classroom Mathematics* in 2021–2022. "We held steady in math with some improvements when everybody else declined," said Dr. Renard Adams, chief of research, assessment, and accountability. "The only thing we had changed was our curriculum."
- 3. The district doubled down on *i-Ready* Professional Learning and **capacity building** in the 2022–2023 school year.
