

Articulation Vowel /oo/ (oa, ow, o_e)

To make the sound /oo/:

- First, open your mouth in the shape of a circle.
- Next, lift the back of your tongue.
- Then, use your voice and let the air flow out of your mouth.
- Place your fingers on your throat and say the sound again.
Do you feel your throat vibrate? (Yes.)
