The following list of words from the decodable text may be unfamiliar to students. Provide word meanings as needed when students read the relevant text part.

Mail Past and Present

Part 1

post office – a building where mail is sent and received

slots – long, thin openings in a box, door, or wall; in some homes, mail is delivered by putting it through a slot in a door or wall

inns – places such as large houses where people pay to sleep, like a small hotel

spots – places

email – short for “electronic mail;” messages sent between electronic devices

snail mail – a nickname for mail delivered to mailboxes; this mail moves more slowly than email
