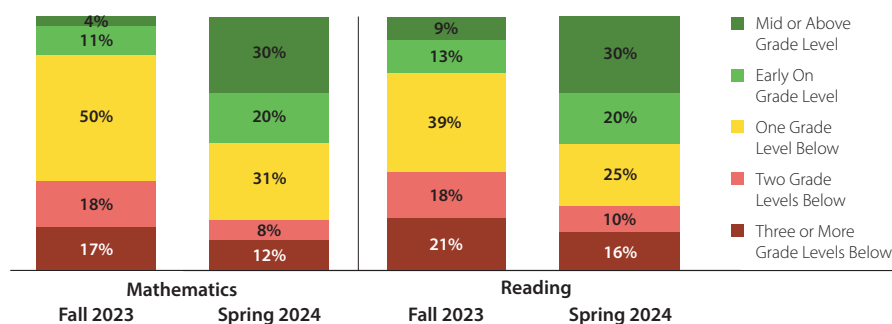


Tyler ISD Proficiency Blossoms with *i-Ready* Personalized Instruction

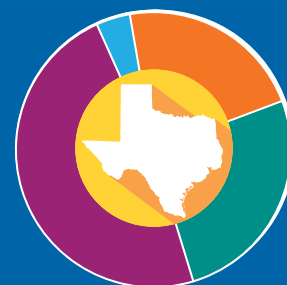
**Tyler ISD Mathematics and Reading Placement Distribution:

Implementing *i-Ready Personalized Instruction* for Mathematics and for Reading with fidelity in their Grades K–8 classrooms, Tyler ISD achieved remarkable growth from their fall to spring Diagnostic. In just one academic year, placements in Mid or Above Grade Level **grew by 26 percentage points in Mathematics—a 650-percent increase—and 21 percentage points in Reading—a 233-percent increase.**

Tyler ISD Students Are Blooming Like the Celebrated Texas Roses

Throughout the 2023–2024 school year, Tyler ISD educators integrated *i-Ready Personalized Instruction's* rigorous, motivating instructional resources and real-time assessments into their daily classroom routines, monitoring students' progress to ensure they were meeting the recommended goals of 30 or more minutes per subject per week and maintaining a lesson pass rate of 70 percent or better. Teachers paid more attention to lesson alerts and lessons passed than time spent and lessons completed, with measurable results.

Deeply invested in these efforts, district leadership teams provided robust coaching, modeling, and support. They also frequently reviewed domain-level performance with principals to ensure students in each school remained on track in their journeys to grade-level proficiency and beyond.

As a result, Tyler ISD achievement surpassed expectations, with students exceeding significant milestones within just one year.

Aligned with Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS)² and approved for Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA)³ eligibility, *i-Ready* targets domain-specific Mathematics and Reading needs to create learning pathways proven to help Texas students reach grade-level proficiency.

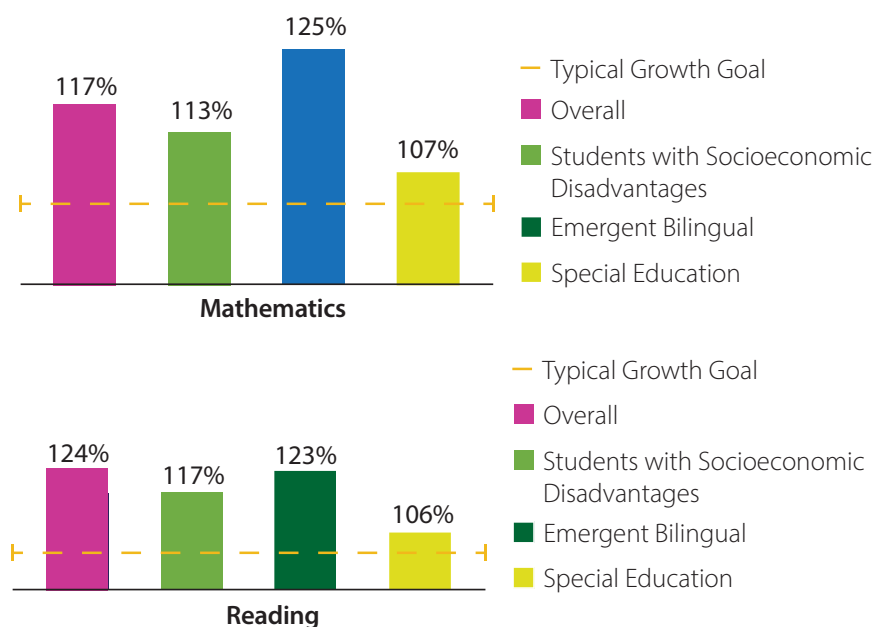

**Tyler ISD Grades K–8 Progress to Annual Typical Growth (Median):
Fall 2023 to Spring 2024**



In a single year of using *i-Ready Personalized Instruction* for Mathematics and for Reading with fidelity, Tyler ISD **exceeded the Typical Growth goal by an average of 17 and 24 percentage points, respectively, across all Grades K–8 student groups.**

The Typical Growth goal is based on data from millions of students nationwide taking the *i-Ready* adaptive assessment. Typical Growth reflects the amount of growth an average student is expected to make from fall to spring.

Birdwell's Intentionality Leads to Impact in Mathematics Achievement

A Spanish immersion magnet campus serving 500 students across Grades Pre-K–8, Birdwell is known for its tight-knit community, professional support, and student focus. When Birdwell fully implemented *i-Ready Personalized Instruction* for Mathematics, student engagement and performance thrived.

Birdwell educators established well-defined goals to set students on a path to success, while ongoing recognition helped maintain their motivation along the way. Celebrations emphasizing the importance of effort and improvement as well as achievement ensured students felt seen and acknowledged in their progress.

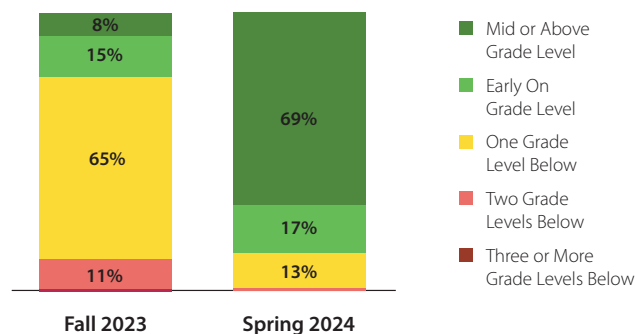

Andy Woods achieved transformative growth, with students passing 70 percent or more of their *i-Ready* lessons in just one academic year.

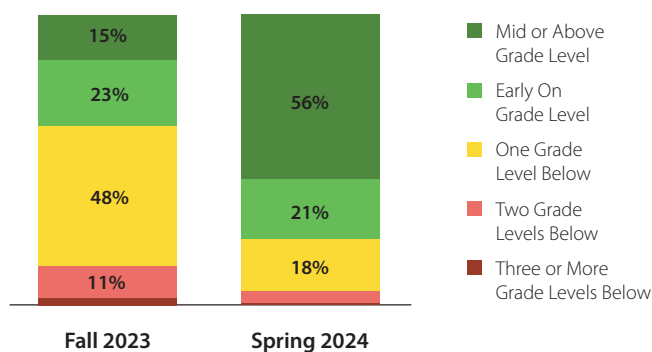
