Brigance Inventory of Early Development III (IED-III): Crosswalk to the Three Child Outcomes

The Brigance Inventory of Early Development III (IED-III) lists the skills children acquire from birth to age eight in the domains of physical, language, academic/cognitive, daily living, and social and emotional development. Practitioners assess children's mastery of the skills via interview, observation, and elicited performance. The IED-III is one of many sources of information that can help teams understand how skills align with the <u>Three Child Outcomes</u> states measure for <u>federal reporting purposes</u>. States report outcomes data to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) each year in the <u>State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR)</u>.

This crosswalk shows how the skills listed in the IED-III cover the <u>Breadth of the Three Child Outcomes</u>, including the six bundles of skills that comprise each outcome. In addition, the IED-III age references the skills, which can be useful for age anchoring when <u>Child Outcomes Summary</u> (<u>COS</u>) teams determine ratings on the COS 7-point scale.

The following tables map the skills listed on the IED-III with the six bundles of skills that comprise each of the three child outcomes. While many skills inform more than one of the three outcomes, double coding was avoided to focus on each skill's strongest relationship to one outcome.
