- 1. By annual review, given appropriate sensory supports, Zachary will read common kindergarten words in 4 of 5 trials for 4 consecutive weeks with 80% accuracy, as measured by student work samples.
- 2. By annual review, given a model and a set of small objects, Blanca will count eight objects correctly in 8 of 10 opportunities for 3 consecutive weeks with 80% accuracy, as measured by data collection documents.
- 3. By <u>annual review</u>, given <u>an appropriate verbal prompt</u>, <u>Quinn</u> will <u>demonstrate willingness to share and take turns</u> in <u>a duration of 30 minutes</u> for <u>4 consecutive weeks</u> with <u>75%</u> accuracy, as measured by <u>data</u> collection documents.
