Synonyms Words or phrases with the same or similar meaning	<i>Teacher:</i> Read each synonym. Students: Repeat each synonym. Students: Circle the synonym to be remembered.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• selection• option
Antonyms Words or phrases with the opposite meaning	<i>Teacher:</i> Read each antonym. Students: Repeat each antonym. Students: Circle the antonym to be remembered.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• no selection• forced decision
