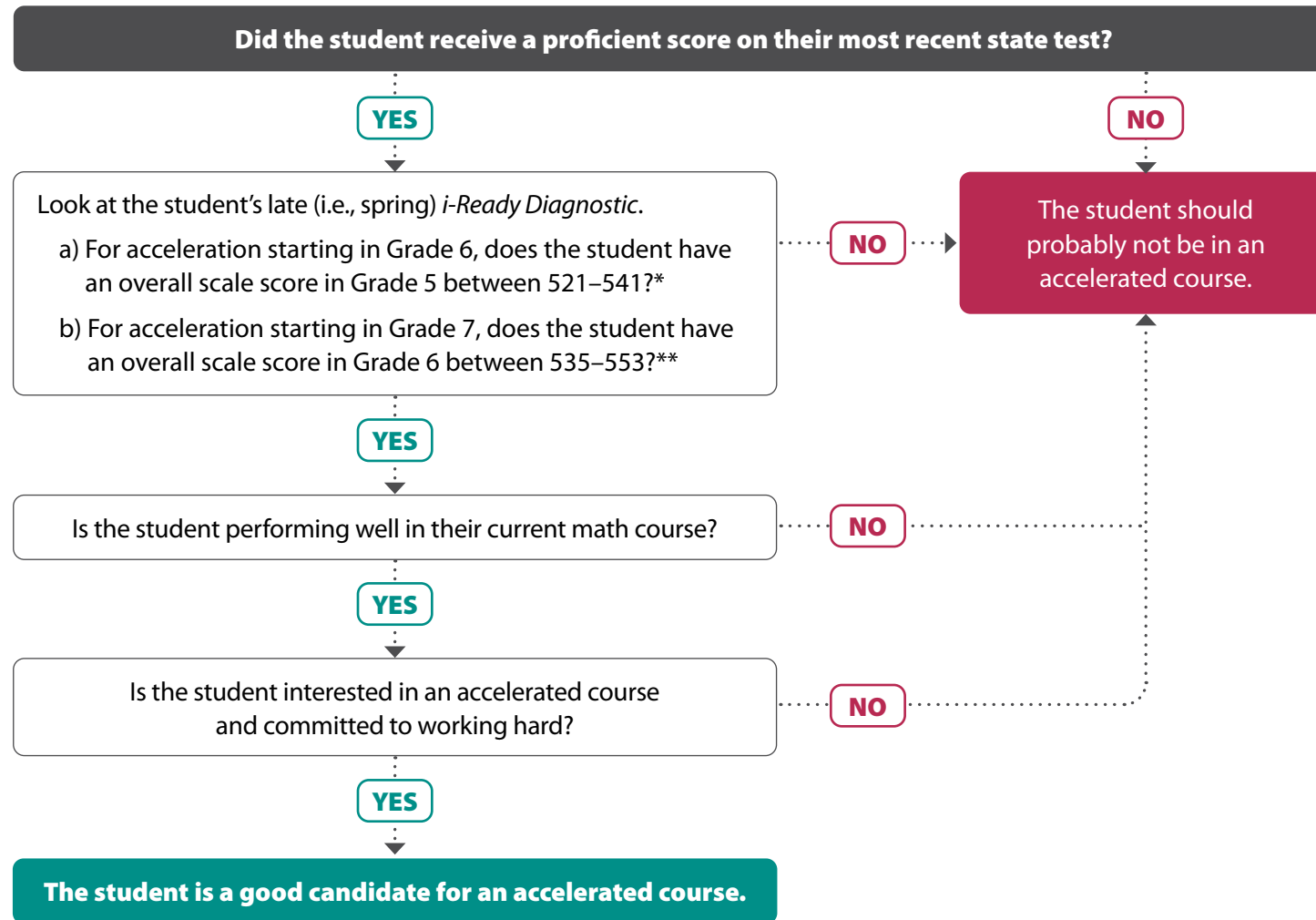


Questions to Consider before Placing a Student in an Accelerated Middle School Mathematics Course



*A scale score at the end of Grade 5 of 521 will include the greatest number of students, a scale score of 527 is standard, a scale score of 534 will be more exclusive in who is in the course, and a scale score of 541 will result in the fewest number of students in an accelerated course starting in Grade 6.

**A scale score at the end of Grade 6 of 535 will include the greatest number of students, a scale score of 541 is standard, a scale score of 547 will be more exclusive in who is in the course, and a scale score of 553 will result in the fewest number of students in an accelerated course starting in Grade 7.
