

Articulation Consonant /fff/ (ff, ph)

To make the sound /fff/:

- First, bring your lower lip and bottom edge of your top teeth together.
- Keep your mouth closed gently as air begins to build up in your mouth.
- Next, let your breath squeeze out and flow over your lower lip and upper teeth.
- Place your fingers on your throat and say the sound again. Do you feel your throat vibrate? (No.)
